MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is J&D Market. This is Case Number 23-PRO-00101, Miku, LLC. 2201 Minnesota Avenue, Southeast. License Number ABRA-103723.

This is a Retailed Class B Grocery and License Renewal. The Protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent.

Is anyone present on behalf of J & D Market? Is anyone present on behalf of J & D Market? Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 8A?

COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Commissioner Muhammad.

MS. FLETCHER: Commissioner Muhammad, would you state your full name and spell it for the record again, please?

COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Okay, yes, ma'am.

Commissioner Holly Muhammad, H-O-L-L-Y M-U-H-A-M-M-A-D.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much, Commissioner.

1 ANC 8A does have standing as a
2 Protestant. The Applicant is not present. The
3 time is approximately 10:29. The Application for
4 Renewal, Commissioner, is dismissed because the
5 Applicant has failed to appear this morning.

6 The Board issues an order dismissing
7 the application and the Applicant will have 10
8 days upon receipt of the order to seek
9 reinstatement of the application. They'll
10 provide an explanation to the Board. The Board
11 will determine whether or not to reinstate
12 the application or not. And you will receive a
13 copy of the Board order and if the Applicant
14 seeks reinstatement you'll have an opportunity to
15 respond to their request to reinstate the
16 application.

17 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Okay. So,
18 they'll send that out to the ANC email, correct?

19 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

20 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Okay. And --

21 MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh?

22 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: The
23 reinstatement is it just the same process, was
24 it like a Protest?

25 MS. FLETCHER: So, it's not the same

1 process. The Applicant can submit a request, a
2 written request, to reinstate the application and
3 the first step is that the Board order goes out
4 dismissing the application which the ANC also
5 receives a copy of.

6 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Okay.

7 MS. FLETCHER: When the Applicant
8 receives the order, the Applicant will have 10
9 days to ask the Board to reinstate the
10 application. If they decide to do that you will
11 be informed and have an opportunity to respond to
12 it. They will give a reason that they want here.
13 You can be okay with that or you may object to it
14 but you'll have an opportunity to respond.

15 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Okay. Thank
16 you.

17 MS. FLETCHER: And then we'll decide
18 whether or not to reinstate the application. If
19 they do, you will hear from me again. I'll
20 contact you to set up a date for mediation, a
21 Status Hearing and a Protest Hearing. We'll pick
22 up where we left off. But that will be just
23 communication through email. You won't come back
24 to do the Roll Call Hearing process.

25 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Okay. Thank

1 you.

2 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome,
3 Commissioner. Thank you very much for coming.

4 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Happy New Year.
5 I'm coming in with a cold.

6 MS. FLETCHER: You sound like you might
7 be a little stuffy.

8 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: Yes.

9 MS. FLETCHER: But I hope you feel
10 better soon.

11 COMMISSIONER MUHAMMAD: All right.
12 Thank you. Have a great day.

13 MS. FLETCHER: You, too, thank you very
14 much. The Roll Call Hearing in this matter is
15 concluded which concludes the hearings for today.
