MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar for today is Rosemarino D'Italia.

This is Case No. 22-PRO-00142. 1714
C, LLC. 1714 Connecticut Avenue NW. License No. ABRA 109613. This is a retailer class CT.

This is a substantial change for an entertainment endorsement with cover charge to provide live entertainment inside of the premises. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet, real property values, residential parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

Is anyone present on behalf of Rosemarino?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes. Sidon Yohannes here on behalf of the licensee. And that is S-I-D-O-N Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
And on behalf of the Dupont Circle Citizens Association?

MS. VOLMAN: Yes. Susan Volman. That's S-U-S-A-N and $V$ as in Victor-O-L-M-A-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.

Volman. And there is a group of, I counted 72. Is anyone available on behalf of the group?

MR. MELCHER: Good morning, Ms. Fletcher. My name is Douglas Melcher. I'm an attorney for the group. My name is spelled D-O-U-G-L-A-S M-E-L-C-H-E-R.

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Melcher, are there any other members from the group present today?

MR. MELCHER: Yes, there are.
MS. FLETCHER: If each person would state their name and spell it for the record please.

MR. GUAGENTI: Nolan Guagenti. N-O-L-A-N G-U-A-G-E-N-T-I.

MS. FLETCHER: How do you spell the last name one more time?

MR. GUAGENTI: G-U-A-G-E-N-T-I.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
MS. GUANTENTI: Nicole Guagenti.
Last name G-U-A-G-E-N-T-I as well.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. CONRAD: Kraig Conrad K-R-A-I-G C-O-N-R-A-D.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.

Conrad.
MR. PROHASKA: Kevin Prohaska K-E-V-I-N, Prohaska is P-R-O-H-A-S-K-A.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. JOHNSON: William Johnson W-I-L-
L-I-A-M J-O-H-N-S-O-N.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. JOHNSON: Debora Johnson D-E-B-O-R-A, it's different. Johnson J-O-H-N-S-O-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MS. WAHL: Barbara Wahl B-A-R-B-A-RA, Wahl W-A-H-L.

MS. FLETCHER: Anyone else?
MS. NG: May Ng M-A-Y N-G.
MR. CARNEAL: Jeff Carneal J-E-F-F
C-A-R-N like Nancy-E-A-L.
MS. FLETCHER: Anyone else? Anyone else? Okay.

I count nine individuals from the group being present today which means that the full group is granted standing as a protestant.

I'm going to give you the next available day for mediation. The status and protest hearing dates are not available today but you'll receive those dates later this week.

The next available day for mediation is Tuesday, February 14 or Wednesday February 15.

Is that good for you, Ms. Volman, the 14th or the 15th?

MS. VOLMAN: Yeah. Either one would work for me or someone else from our organization.

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Melcher?
MR. MELCHER: The 14th would be fine. Just so you're aware. At least two of the parties have discussed the possibility of consolidating this protest proceeding with another one which has a status hearing set for the 15th so just to avoid complications I would prefer the 14th and then we'll work out the dates.

MS. FLETCHER: So Mr. Melcher, what's the other case?

MR. MELCHER: It also concerns Rosemarino obviously but let me see if I can get you the case number.

MS. FLETCHER: That's okay. This one for today is related to the substantial change. That one is related to another
license.
MR. MELCHER: Renewal. And there is some discussion about trying to consolidate those two proceedings just for the sake of efficiency. But obviously that needs to be done with the board's approval so --

MS. FLETCHER: That's right. I'm just making a note her because what you would like to do if possible, is consolidate them and have the mediations on the same day?

MR. MELCHER: I believe so. Maybe the licensee's attorney can speak to that as well?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes. No, I agree with Counsel. In terms of consolidation, we would prefer to consolidate the mediation as well as the hearing, protest hearing. So it you know, I'm fine putting in something for now and if the board approves a motion that we've put forth we can just have one mediation date as well as a protest hearing day.

MS. FLETCHER: And may I ask you one other thing about the renewal? Has it been placarded already?

MR. MELCHER: Yes.

MS. YOHANNES: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Do you know the roll call date for that one?

MR. MELCHER: We already had it.
MS. FLETCHER: You already had it?
MS. YOHANNES: It was the --
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So you've already had the roll call for the renewal?

MS. YOHANNES: We had the roll call, and the mediation was scheduled for January 10th at noon.

MS. FLETCHER: So would you prefer to combine them to the January 10 date for mediation or the date that I'm going to give you right now?

MS. YOHANNES: I would prefer to go ahead and, if everyone else on this call is okay with it, say January 10th at noon.

MS. FLETCHER: And let me ask you something else. So obviously I don't have that case with me, but was the Dupont Circle Citizens Association a protestant in that case as well?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes.
MS. VOLMAN: Yes. And the ANC. And
they agreed. They were happy with the January 10.

MS. FLETCHER: What about the group of 72? Were they a protestant in the renewal as well?

MS. VOLMAN: Yes. All three parties are protesting both.

MS. FLETCHER: But the ANC is a part of the renewal protest?

MS. VOLMAN: They are yeah. And this one as far as I know.

MR. MELCHER: That's correct. The ANC is a part of that.

MS. FLETCHER: Excuse me one second. You said the parties are all the same. One second here. So that would be ANC 2B?

MS. VOLMAN: Yes.
MS. YOHANNES: Yes.
MS. VOLMAN: They were present for the previous roll call. I don't know where they are today. Maybe they didn't get the invite.

MS. FLETCHER: Well they're not here today. That's what I was checking to --

MR. MELCHER: Ms. Fletcher,
regarding dates. I think to have an effective mediation it might be better to use the later date that was being discussed. There's not a lot of time to prepare between now and next week for mediation so the group would prefer to go with the February date that you provided.

MS. FLETCHER: Well that's good on this end.

MS. VOLMAN: That's fine with me. Either way. I think also if they have to be consolidated, that give the board time to consolidate them.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So what I'm going to do, I'm making myself a note here to -- I'm going to cancel the mediation set for January 10 and reschedule that, assuming that they're going to be combined, I'm going to reschedule both for Tuesday, February 14. Any time between 10:00 and 1:30.

MR. MELCHER: 10:00 a.m. would work for me.

MS. YOHANNES: 10:30 would --
MS. FLETCHER: Who, I'm sorry, who was that speaking? I'm not getting the names for the court reporter. They always need to
know who's speaking. So who just said 10:00 a.m. is okay?

MR. MELCHER: I apologize. This is Douglas Melcher on behalf of the group of five or more. 10:00 a.m. or 10:30 is fine.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Melcher.

Ms. Volman, what about you?
MS. VOLMAN: Any time that works for them and Sidon is fine with me.

MS. YOHANNES: And this is Sidon, I'm okay with any time 10:30 or after.

MS. FLETCHER: Well then let's make it 10:30 then. So mediation for Rosemarino D'Italia is set for Tuesday, February 14 at 10:30.

And so ANC 2B is not present today.
MR. GUAGENTI: Ms. Fletcher, ANC 2B

MS. FLETCHER: Who's speaking?
MR. GUAGENTI: Oh Sorry, this is Nolan Guagenti. ANC 2B, Jeff is going to be joining in about three minutes. Do you need him to attend the ANC?

MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, if he filed.

If they filed the protest they need to attend. So Nolan, you just mentioned somebody's name. So can you spell the persons name you just mentioned?

MR. GUAGENTI: Yeah. Hold on one second. Jeff Rueckgauer J-E-F-F-R-E-Y, Rueckgauer R-U-E-C-K-G-A-U-E-R. He's with ANC --

MS. FLETCHER: And you said --
MR. GUAGENTI: ANC 2B. And also Meg Roggensack is also going to be joining here in a couple of minutes.

MS. FLETCHER: Can you spell her name as well?

MR. GUAGENTI: Yep. $M-E-G$, and Roggensack R-O-G-G-E-N-S-A-C-K.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So they're going to be coming in a couple minutes. They have the link already? Someone's --

MR. GUAGENTI: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
Okay. So we'll wait a moment if that's okay with everybody. So what I'm going to do is this. The Dupont Circle Citizens Association has standing as a protestant and so does the
group of 72. I'll give ANC 2B an opportunity to appear.

And what I'm going to do in the meantime, I'm going to recall this case. I'm going to close this case for now, I'm going to recall it in just a few minutes. So if you could all just stay on the line. Except the individuals that are on the line, you don't need to stay.

Mr. Melcher, if you could stay, everyone else can sign off if you like. The group has already been granted standing but you're free to stay if you like.
(Whereupon, the above-entitle matter went off the record at 10:20 a.m. and resumed at 10:24 a.m.)

MR. GUAGENTI: Ms. Fletcher?
MS. FLETCHER: I'm getting -- I see a message from ANC 2B that they're having trouble signing in.

Is that what you were going to tell me Nolan?

MR. GUAGENTI: Yes. Yes, ma'am. And is there a phone number that they can use to dial in?

MS. FLETCHER: Yeah. And I'm -who's trying to call? Meg, right?

MR. GUAGENTI: Meg. Yes. Yes, ma'am.

MS. ROGGENSACK: Yes. So I'm finally here. Sorry about that.

MS. FLETCHER: Oh that's okay. No problem.

MS. ROGGENSACK: I was you know I misunderstood our exchange this morning, but I appreciate that you're on -- I didn't have a workable link. So I appreciate that.

MS. FLETCHER: No problem at all. I was just about to forward you another one.

Can you state your name and spell it for the record please?

MS. ROGGENSACK: Meg Roggensack, and I am both the representative of single member district ANC 2B-01 and the current chair of the Dupont Circle ANC. My name is spelled M-E-G R-O-G-G-E-N-S-A-C-K.

MS. FLETCHER: And Ms. Roggensack, ANC 2B does have standing as a protestant. So Ms. Roggensack you have standing as a protestant in the matter of Rosemarino D'Italia
so I'm going to re-open that case. I closed it momentarily to give you an opportunity to appear.

MS. ROGGENSACK: Thank you. I appreciate that.

MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome. So I'm going to re-open that case now, Rosemarino, noting the fact that Ms. Roggensack is present.

And just in summary, we have three protestants in this case now. We have the Dupont Circle Citizens Association, ANC 2B, and a group of 72.

We need to set a date for mediation. I'll give you the next day available. The dates for the status and protest hearing are not available to me today but you'll get those dates later this week.

The next day available for mediation is Tuesday, February 21 or Wednesday, February 22 any time between 10:00 and 1:00. So what about February 21, is that good for anybody?

MS. YOHANNES: Sorry, Ms. Fletcher I think we set a date for mediation.

MS. FLETCHER: We already -- oh

MS. YOHANNES: As a result of consolidating.

MS. FLETCHER: For the 14th?
MS. YOHANNES: Exactly.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. We were just waiting for Ms. Roggensack.

MS. YOHANNES: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Yeah.
MS. YOHANNES: And I would like her to know that we do intend, or there has been communications about consolidation. Separately and outside of this we will catch the parties up and hope that the parties all agree so that we can submit something to the board jointly.

But the date that we are hoping on having is February 14th at 10:30 a.m. so we can have a mediation with this matter being the matter for substantial change and the renewal application that's already pending before the board.

MS. FLETCHER: So Ms. Roggensack, would you be okay with combining the cases so that the mediation for both cases take place on the same day?

MS. ROGGENSACK: I defer to the
neighbors. Are we talking about the 14th of February?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MS. ROGGENSACK: So Counsel for the neighbors, Counsel Melcher, is that acceptable to you?

MR. MELCHER: Yes. This is Doug Melcher speaking. We already discussed this with Ms. Fletcher and yes that date is acceptable, and we did look into the possibility of consolidation and spoke with the licensee's counsel about that. So that is all acceptable to the group.

MS. ROGGENSACK: All right. And I
assume DCCA is also waiting on that?
MS. VOLMAN: Yeah. We're fine and we prefer that they be consolidated and therefore $I$ think we've already agreed to cancel the January 10th scheduled mediation, just for your information.

MS. FLETCHER: So you're going to get a WebEx from me cancelling the mediation for January 10 and scheduling it for February 14 at 10:30 instead.

Let's see if there's anything else.

No, there's nothing else.
Any questions from anybody? Well thank you for coming and I will see you on February 14.

MR. MELCHER: Thank you, Ms. Fletcher.

MS. ROGGENSACK: Thank you very much for your consideration.

MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.
MR. GUAGENTI: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: The roll call hearing in this matter is concluded.

If you will give me a moment to check an email, $I$ received an email from someone just a moment ago related to the hearing this morning. Just hold on one second.

MS. ROGGENSACK: That likely is me.
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay. Well you know what, I'm good then.

MS. ROGGENSACK: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Roggensack, that was you?

MS. ROGGENSACK: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very much.

MS. ROGGENSACK: Thank you. Byebye.

MS. FLETCHER: Bye-bye.
