We protested because there was no representation from Giant at our previous meeting when we were giving renewals an opportunity to address any infractions that have occurred.

We were unable to get anyone from Giant to attend the meeting. We now have contact with Mr. O'Brien, who's planning on attending the meeting tomorrow, and while I'm happy to schedule a conversation for mediation for the 26th, I believe we will have this resolved by 8pm tomorrow evening. So should we schedule and then remove once we have achieved our goal of talking tomorrow?

MS. FLETCHER: It will be set for 3:00, 1 2 and then let us know what has been resolved and 3 we'll just cancel it. COMMISSIONER EICHLER: Sure, Just let 4 5 me work my calendar view to make sure that I am 6 free for 3:00 on the 26th. So the 26th at 3, I 7 cannot do. 3:30? MS. FLETCHER: 3:30 would work on this 8 9 end. 10 COMMISSIONER EICHLER: Is it actually going to be at 3:30, or is it going to be a 11 12 window? I can do 3:30, yes. MS. FLETCHER: It will be for whatever 13 14 time we set. If that's okay with Mr. O'Brien, 15 it's okay on this end. MR. O'BRIEN: It's not a general call 16 17 like this meeting. It will just be us.
