3 MS. FLETCHER: I am now calling Case
4 #20-PRO-00055. That's Charles Corner, Super
5 Investments Inc., t/a Charles Corner, 2600 Wade
6 Road, SE. License No. ABRA-094783. This is a
7 Retailer Class B, Application to Renew License.
8 Mr. Adofo, are you still there?

9 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Yes, ma'am.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. This is your case
11 as well. Thank you. Is Mr. Oh present? Charles Oh
12 (Phonetic)? Mr. Adofo, Charles Oh is the owner of
13 the establishment. He's not here, he's not
14 present, but he called me this morning to say
15 that he did not receive his invitations, although
16 I sent him two invitations to the two email
17 addresses that he gave me.

18 For some reason he did not receive
19 them. I'm not going to dismiss him because he's
20 not here. He called me, and he was sent
21 invitations. I'm not going to dismiss him as an
22 Applicant. There may be some technical reason
23 that he couldn't join us. But he called me prior
24 to the hearing to tell me that he had not
25 received his two invitations.

1 So I'm not going to dismiss Mr. Oh.
2 I'm going to make a note to call him. I don't
3 know the reason he did not receive the invitation
4 to bring -- I don't know if they went to his junk
5 mail, who knows.

6 But I'm going to grant standing to the
7 ANC. Adofo, you're already coming on the 19th.
8 Would you like them both on the same day?

9 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Sure.

10 MS. FLETCHER: It's up to you.

11 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Actually, I would
12 rather not.

13 MS. FLETCHER: You would rather not?
14 Okay. Well, how about the 20th of January?

15 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Okay.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Tell me if that's too
17 much. I'm just trying to move along.

18 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Yes, ma'am. I
19 fully understand.

20 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: The 20th at 10am
21 is fine.

22 COMMISSIONER SILVERSTEIN: Is the 20th
23 a legal holiday because it's inauguration day?

24 MS. FLETCHER: The 18th is a holiday.
25 Okay, Mr. Adofo, the mediation for Charles Corner

1 is set for 10:00 on (telephonic interference). If
2 anything changes, you can let me know. Hopefully
3 both of those are good times and I will see you
4 then.

5 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Yes, ma'am.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Take care.
