3 MS. FLETCHER: This is the matter of
4 Lucky Corner Market, Case #20-PRO-00058, YD
5 Progress LLC, 5433 Georgia Avenue, NW, License
6 #ABRA-093115. This is a Retailer Class B
7 Application to Renew. The protest issues in this
8 case are adverse impact on peace, order, and
9 quiet. Who's present on behalf of Lucky Corner
10 Market?

11 MR. CLAYTON: Good morning. This is
12 Robert Clayton, R-O-B-E-R-T C-L-A-Y-T-O-N.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr Clayton.
14 Is your client present as well?

15 MR. CLAYTON: No.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. Who is
17 present on behalf of ANC 4D? Is Mr. Tabor
18 present? Mr. Tabor, are you there? Is anyone
19 present on behalf of ANC 4D?

20 Mr. Clayton, have you had any
21 communication with ANC 4D?

22 MR. CLAYTON: I have in the past, and
23 we

24 MS. FLETCHER: Related to this case?

25 MR. CLAYTON: Yes, yes, and we

1 discussed the current settlement agreement and
2 its impact, whether or not it's sufficient to
3 satisfy the issues that would be raised by the
4 ANC.

5 Unfortunately, we have not received a
6 copy of the actual protest that the ANC has
7 raised, so we don't know if they've decided to
8 dismiss their protest or what the current status
9 is.

10 MS. FLETCHER: ANC 4D is dismissed, the
11 protest is dismissed because they failed to
12 appear today. Mr. Clayton, what that means is
13 that the ABC Board will issue an order dismissing
14 the protest.

15 MR. CLAYTON: Correct.

16 MS. FLETCHER: You will receive a copy
17 of the order. AND 4D will have ten days to seek a
18 reinstatement of the protest. If they do, you'll
19 have an opportunity to respond to that. We're not
20 going to set any dates today, but you'll receive
21 a copy of the Board order dismissing the protest
22 and then we'll go from there.

23 If the Board reinstates the protest,
24 I'll contact the parties to set a date for
25 mediation. Any questions, Mr. Clayton?

1 MR. CLAYTON: No, none at all. Thank
2 you.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very
4 much. Have a nice day.
