17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms.
18	Yohannes, I see why this case was re-called. All
19	right. It is my understanding that there is an
20	offer and compromise and the offer and compromise
21	is that the parties have agreed to the issuance
22	of a warning.
23	Is this your understanding of the
24	offer and compromise?
25	MS. YOHANNES: Yes, it is.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client	
2	aware that by accepting an offer and compromise	
3	that they give up their right to a hearing?	
4	MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

8	appeal this matter?	
9	MS. YOHANNES: Yes.
