The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson presiding.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The	
4	next case on our calendar is Case Number	
5	19-251-00116, Sing Sing Karaoke Palace, License	
6	Number 72783.	
7	Ms. Andrews, can you please elevate	
8	the rights of the Licensee in this case, please?	
9	MS. ANDREWS: Sure. Mr. Martin, your	
10	rights have been elevated. And that's all, Mr.	
11	Chair.	
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.	
13	Ms. Krupke, can you please identify	
14	yourself for the record and please spell your	
15	name?	
16	MS. KRUPKE: Sure. Jessica Krupke on	
17	behalf of the District of Colombia. K-R-U-P-K-E.	
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon.	
19	Mr. Martin, can you please identify yourself for	
20	the record, please, and spell your name?	
21	MR. MARTIN: Jason Martin. J-A-S-O-N,	
22	M-A-R-T-I-N. Representing Bee Hive, LLC, Sticky	
23	Rice and Sing Sing.	
24	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,	
25	thank you.	

1	Ms. Yohannes are you in this case?	
2	No, all right. All right no, or yes and no?	
3	MS. YOHANNES: No, I am not.	
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay, thanks.	
5	All right.	
6	Ms. Krupke, are there any preliminary	
7	matters in this case?	
8	MS. KRUPKE: No, the parties do not	
9	have an offer in compromise for the Board's	
10	consideration today.	
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,	
12	thank you. Then this matter is scheduled for a	
13	show cause hearing at a date to be determined.	
14	Thank you, Ms. Krupke.	
15	MR. MARTIN: I had put in a request	
16	that I agreed with the OIC with Mr. Steven, what	
17	is his -	
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Steven	
19	Ortiz?	
20	MS. KRUPKE: Mr. Ortiz?	
21	MR. MARTIN: Yes. But when I sent Mr.	
22	Ortiz the agreement he had said his vacation	
23	responder was on. I'd like to just go ahead,	
24	agree to it, and pay the fine.	
25	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Krupke, are	

you aware of what OIC that was offered to Mr. 1 2 Martin? 3 MS. KRUPKE: If I can have your 4 indulgence for just a moment, I'll be able to 5 pull that up. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 6 Yes. 7 MS. KRUPKE: Thank you. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. 9 (Pause.) 10 MS. KRUPKE: All right, so I haven't 11 pulled up, what I believe should have been 12 offered. And so, obviously, the establishment can correct me if this is not his understanding. 13 14 So, for this particular series of 15 violations, there are two charges. The first is 16 failure to ensure the cameras were operational in 17 violation of D.C. Code 25-403(e)(3)(g)(I). 18 is a primary tier violation and the second 19 primary tier violation within two years. The 20 offer in compromise was for \$2,000 payable within 21 90 days or the license would be suspended 22 indefinitely until the fine is paid. 23 For Charge 2, the charge is no ABC 24 manager on duty on June 17th, 2019, in violation

of D.C. Code 25-701. This is a secondary tier

violation, and it's the seventh secondary tier 1 2 violation within four years. And the offer in 3 compromise was \$2,000 payable within 90 days or 4 the license shall be suspended indefinitely until 5 the fine is paid. So it's a total of \$4,000 payable 6 7 within 90 days for the two charges that I just 8 explained. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Martin, Ms. 10 Krupke mentioned an offer in compromise. Is this 11 the offer in compromise -- is this your 12 understanding of the offer in compromise? 13 MR. MARTIN: Yes. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Are 15 you aware that by accepting that offer in 16 compromise that you're giving up your right to a 17 hearing? 18 MR. MARTIN: Yes. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also 20 aware that by accepting the offer in compromise 21 that you're giving up your right to appeal this 22 matter? 23 MR. MARTIN: Yes. 24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

With that said, I then make a motion that the

1	offer in compromise for Charge 1, a fine of		
2	\$2,000 payable with 90 days, be accepted; for		
3	Charge 2, also a fine of \$2,000 payable within 90		
4	days; for a total fine of \$4,000 payable within		
5	90 days. If the fine is not paid within 90 days		
6	the license will be suspended until the fine has		
7	been paid.		
8	Is there a second?		
9	MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett		
10	seconds.		
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett		
12	has seconded the motion. I will now make a roll		
13	call vote on the motion that's been properly		
14	seconded by Ms. Crockett.		
15	Mr. Short?		
16	MEMBER SHORT: Ms. Short. I agree.		
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?		
18	MEMBER CROCKETT: Bobby Cato. I		
19	agree.		
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Wahabzadah?		
21	MEMBER WAHABZADAH: Rema Wahabzadah.		
22	I agree.		
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?		
24	MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett. I		
25	agree.		

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?	
2	MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen. I agree.	
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?	
4	MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis. I	
5	disagree.	
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.	
7	I agree. The matter therefore passed 6 to 1 with	
8	Mr. Grandis in disagreement.	
9	I especially want to thank you, Mr.	
10	Martin, for agreeing to this OIC. I appreciate	
11	your efforts to bring closure to this matter, and	
12	I thank you for that. And thank you, Ms. Krupke.	
13	So, anyway, have a great day. But I	
14	appreciate the parties work in this matter. I	
15	thank you very much.	
16	MR. MARTIN: Thank you.	
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.	
18	Then have a great day.	
19	MS. KRUPKE: Thank you.	
20	(Whereupon, the above-entitled matter	
21	went off the record at 2:11 p.m.)
