CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, we're on the record. Good morning, everyone. As chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the District of Columbia, I am welcoming you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.
