The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Good morning everyone. Thank you for participating in ABRA's roll call hearing via the WebEx platform provided by the DC Office of Open Government. My name is Laverne Fletcher. I will be conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent.

There are two cases on the calendar today. The first case on the calendar today is DC City Smokehouse. This is case number 23-PRO-0001, Southeast Restaurant Group LLC, 203 Florida Avenue, NW, License Number ABRA 098368. This is a retailer Class CT license renewal.

The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet, real property values, and residential parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety. My name is Laverne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is anyone present on behalf of DC City Smokehouse?

MR. HINES: I am.

MS. FLETCHER: If you would state your name and spell it for the record, please.

MR. HINES: My name is Melvin Hines,

2	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Hines.
3	We have a couple of protestants in this matter.
4	Is Mr. Brown present?
5	MR. HINES: I am. My name is Melvin
6	Hines, E-L-V-I-N,
7	MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry, can you say
8	that again?
9	MR. BROWN: Good morning, this is Cory
10	Brown.
11	MS. FLETCHER: Oh, Mr. Brown, could you
12	spell your name for the record, please?
13	MR. BROWN: It's C-O-R-Y, B-R-O-W-N.
14	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Ms.
15	Schumacher. I'm sorry, Mr. Brown.
16	MR. BROWN: We are getting some
17	feedback from somebody else, that was not me.
18	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, yes, I heard that
19	too. Thank you. Ms. Schumacher, are you here?
20	MS. SCHUMACHER: Yes. Hi, J-A-C-Q-U-E-
21	L-I-N-E, S-C-H-U-M-A-C-H-E-R. Thanks so much.
22	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
23	Mr. Brown, am I pronouncing that correctly,
24	Schumacher?
25	MS. SCHUMACHER: It is Schumacher, but

close enough.

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MS. FLETCHER: Schumacher. Ms.
Schumacher, you and Mr. Brown filed protest as abutting property owners, and so that is the determination that has been made. I checked the DC geographic information system, and I can see that your buildings are abutting, so that I can see. What I cannot see, but you can tell me, is whether or not your units actually abut the establishment. Ms. Schumacher, you are in unit number 6, and so does that unit actually touch the establishment at any point?

MS. SCHUMACHER: Yes, ma'am, it does. The way that our building is arranged is that unit 6 is sort of on the left top side of the building, and Cory's is on the right top side of the building directly above the restaurant. So I'm not so familiar with the layout of the restaurant. I cannot say if I am above the kitchen or the dining area, but we're both right on top of restaurant side by side.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Mr. Brown, the same applies for your unit.

MR. BROWN: Yes, correct, both of our units are directly above and touch the kitchen

1	areas and the main restaurant area.
2	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. In
3	that case you are considered abutting property
4	owners. Mr. Hines, still there?
5	Mr. Hines disappeared. I am going to
6	give him a moment.
7	Mr. Hines, can you hear me?
8	Mr. Hines may be having some technical
9	difficulties, I'm not sure, but -
10	MR. HINES: I'm sorry, this is a bad
11	connection.
12	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Hines, can you hear
13	me?
14	Ms. Brown and Ms. Schumacher are
15	granted standing as abutting property owners.
16	Mr. Hines,
17	MR. HINES: I'm sorry, this is a bad
18	connection.
19	MS. FLETCHER: That is okay. If
20	anything I need to tell you beyond this hearing
21	_
22	(Simultaneous speaking.)
23	MR. HINES: this is a bad
24	connection.
25	MS. FLETCHER: That's okay. Can you

hear me now?

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MR. HINES: Ms. Fletcher, I'm not sure if you were saying something, but I cannot -- it is like I am hearing every few words. Ms. Fletcher, I'm sorry I cannot hear what you are saying.

MS. FLETCHER: That's okay. I will send you an email following of the roll call hearing to let you know what transpired, but this is what is happening. Standing is granting to Ms. Brown - Mr. Brown and Ms. Schumacher as an abutting property owners. We need to schedule a date for a mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing. Mr. Brown and Ms. Schumacher can you still hear me?

(Off-microphone comments.)

MS. FLETCHER: Just a second. Mr Hines, can you hear me?

MR. HINES: Now I can. I did not hear anything that you just said, and I thought I heard my name a couple of times.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, I am going to repeat it again, but I am going to follow up this hearing with an email, because I think there has been some disconnection in and out. What I said,

1 Mr. Hines, is that Mr. Brown and Ms. Schumacher 2 are granted standing as abutting property owners. We need to set a date for a mediation, the status 3 4 hearing and a protest hearing. I am going to 5 give you the dates of the status and protest 6 hearing first. Mr. Hines, you are going to say 7 something? MR. HINES: Yes, I just have a 8 9 question. They are granted, I guess, they have 10 authority because their units abut my unit, 11 however, neither one of them lived in those 12 units, so I do not know if that is a 13 technicality, but the fact is neither one of them have been or live in their units at this time. 14 15 MS. FLETCHER: Are they owners of the 16 units? Okay, Mr. Brown. 17 MR. BROWN: Yes. 18 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Schumacher. 19 MR. BROWN: We own our units, and we 20 have tenants that live in them currently, but we 21 still qualify as abutting property owners, and I 2.2 hold the deed for the property. 23 MS. FLETCHER: That is correct. That 2.4 is the same for you, Ms. Schumacher?

MS. SCHUMACHER: Yes.

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1 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. So, 2 Mr. Hines, that answers your question? 3 MR. HINES: Yes, ma'am. MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. I am going 4 5 to give you the dates for the status and protest hearing first. The status hearing is scheduled 6 7 for March 8th, March 8, 2023 at 10:30 for the status hearing. The protest hearing is set for 8 9 April 5, 2023 at 1:30 in the afternoon. We need to set a date for mediation to occur prior to the 10 11 status hearing. I will give you the next available date for mediation. 12 13 (Off-microphone comments.) 14 MS. FLETCHER: The next available day 15 for mediation is - see hear, is Thursday, 16 February 2nd anytime between 10:00 and 1:30 in 17 the afternoon. That is Thursday, February 2nd, 18 that is the next available day that is available. 19 Is that a good day for you, Mr. Hines? MR. HINES: February 2nd, yes, I have 20 21 availability. MS. FLETCHER: What about you, Mr. 2.2 23 Brown and Ms. Schumacher? 2.4 MR. BROWN: That works for me, yes. 25 MS. SCHUMACHER: Okay.

1	MS. FLETCHER: Do you prefer - is
2	10:00 a.m. good?
3	MS. SCHUMACHER: Yes, please, earlier
4	in the morning is better for me. Thank you.
5	MR. BROWN: That works for me as well,
6	thank you.
7	MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for
8	Thursday, February 2nd at 10:00 a.m., and I will
9	send you the WebEx invitation to attend the
10	mediation. Any questions at all?
11	MR. BROWN: Could you repeat - I think
12	you mentioned a hearing on the 5th of April, was
13	that the date?
14	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, the - yes, so
15	April 5, 2023 at 1:30 is the protest hearing. So
16	Ms. Ramos -
17	MR. HINES: What time was that, I'm
18	sorry.
19	MS. FLETCHER: Just a second. Mr.
20	Hines, just a second. Ms. Ramos, if you can hear
21	me please mute yourself, I am hearing some
22	background talking on your end. Thank you.
23	Now, what were you saying, Mr. Hines?
24	MR. HINES: Would you repeat the time
25	on April 5th?

1	MS. FLETCHER: The time on April 5th is
2	1:30 in the afternoon. April 5, 2023 at 1:30,
3	that is the protest hearing.
4	MR. HINES: Okay. Thank you.
5	MS. FLETCHER: If this matter can be
6	resolved in mediation there will not be a protest
7	hearing, otherwise the protest hearing will take
8	place on that date at that time. Any other
9	questions, Mr. Hines?
10	MR. HINES: As far as mediation, is
11	that just the three of us? Is there someone from
12	ABRA that is going to be present as well? How
13	does that process work?
14	MS. FLETCHER: The Board's mediator
15	will be present, that is me.
16	MR. HINES: Okay.
17	MS. FLETCHER: You, me, Mr. Brown, and
18	Ms. Schumacher that is the only parties to the
19	protest.
20	MR. HINES: Okay.
21	MS. FLETCHER: Anything else, Mr.
22	Hines?
23	MR. HINES: No, not from me. Thank
24	you.
25	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you

1	for coming, and I will see you on February 2nd.
2	MR. HINES: All right, and thank you.
3	MS. FLETCHER: Roll call hearing in
4	this matter is concluded. Thank you for coming.
5	MR. BROWN: Thank you.
6	MS. SCHUMACHER: Thank you, ma'am.
7	MS. FLETCHER: You are welcome.
8	(Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
9	went off the record at 10:16 a.m.)
