There are 11 cases scheduled for today 2 -- this morning's agenda. 3 Once your case is called, I will take 4 a moment for IT Specialist to elevate the rights 5 of each party to enable their camera and 6 7 microphone. 8 Then and only then will you have the 9 ability to enable your equipment. If your case is not being heard, you 10 11 will remain mute and your camera will be 12 disabled. At the conclusion of each case, the 13 14 parties will have the option to leave. 15 If a party chooses to stay, all 16 cameras and microphones for the concluded case will be disabled. 17 18 Should you have any questions or require technical assistance during the hearing, 19 20 please submit them using the question and answer 21 feature. 2.2 I will now apologize to the public. 23 I know that we were scheduled to start at 10:30 2.4 this morning. It is now 10:54. 25 As you know, the Board was on winter

1 break since December 15th. 2 We had a significant amount of 3 administrative work. See Board Order Number 2023-703. 16 The protestant, I believe, had filed 17 18 a motion for reconsideration and we have decided on our -- which I will announce on our legal 19 20 agenda, we have -- the Board will vote to deny 21 that motion for reconsideration on our legal 2.2 agenda this morning. 23 So, that case has been dismissed.
