12	MR. ENDALE: Yosef Endale, Y-O-S-E-F,
13	my last name's Endale, E-N-D-A-L-E.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And can you ask
15	him to state what is his relationship to this
16	establishment?
17	MR. ENDALE: Yes, I'm the owner.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,
19	thank you.
20	Commissioner, can you please spell and
21	state your name for the record, please?
22	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: Yes,
23	Commissioner Courniotes, C-O-U-R
24	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What is your
25	first name ma'am? First and last name ma'am?

1	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: Okay,	
2	Commissioner Chrysanthe Courniotes, C-H-R-Y-S-A-	
3	N-T-H-E C-O-U-R-N-I-O-T-E-S.	
4	And I'm representing Commission 4D in	
5	this matter.	
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.	
7	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: Good	
8	morning.	
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, Mr.	
10	Clayton	
11	And ma'am, I would like you to Ms.	
12	Balkew, I need you to interpret everything that's	
13	being stated, okay, ma'am?	
14	MS. BALKEW: Okay.	
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, Mr.	
16	Clayton, are there any preliminary matters in	
17	this case?	
18	MR. CLAYTON: There are no preliminary	
19	matters.	
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Courniotes,	
21	are there any preliminary matters in this case,	
22	ma'am?	
23	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: Not that I'm	
24	aware of.	
25	We did meet recently for a mediation	

1 and it looks as though, you know, we are moving 2 towards that in this case. 3 So, that's my update. 4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, 5 thank you. If this matter then is not settled, it 6 7 is -- it's scheduled for a protest hearing on 8 February 7, 2024 at 1:30 p.m. 9 MR. CLAYTON: I'd like say, Chairman, that the parties have, in fact, reached a 10 11 settlement at the mediation that was held last Thursday, I believe. 12 13 The -- at this point, the only thing we need to do is finalize the terms of the 14 15 agreement. 16 So, we did reach an agreement at the 17 mediation. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, 19 thank you for that representation, Mr. Clayton. 20 Hold on one minute, please. 21 All right, if this matter then is 2.2 settled, then I'll ask the parties to provide us 23 the agreement as soon as possible so we can take this matter off our calendar. Okay? 2.4 25 COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: If an

1 agreement is not finalized, then, you know, if 2 the protest hearing is to be held on February 7th at 1:30, correct? 3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That is 4 5 correct. And one thing I wanted to inform the 6 7 parties, if you believe that this case is going 8 to be settled and if you need more time past 9 February 7th, let us know and we can continue this case. 10 11 This is to renew a license. So, if 12 the parties truly believe that this case can be 13 settled and if you need more time beyond the 14 February 7th date, send us a mutual extension of 15 time and the Board will grant that. Okay? 16 COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: And do we 17 send it to ABCA Law? Is that the email or --18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, yes. 19 And it should be a joint motion by 20 both parties and we will grant it. Okay? 21 COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: Okay. 2.2 And that is true for the settlement 23 agreement itself, also, right? 2.4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Once -- yes. 25 Okay?

2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And I think	
3	Go ahead, ma'am.	
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And the email	
5	information is presented in the chat. So, you	
6	can find it in the chat.	
7	All right, any other questions by	
8	anyone?	
9	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: I have just	
10	one, sorry.	
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, ma'am?	
12	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: Just once	
13	clarifying question, Chairman.	
14	I was just curious, is that mutually	
15	agreed upon settlement agreement, I apologize for	
16	the similar wording, but that should be submitted	
17	by the Commission, correct?	
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Either party.	
19	Once it's signed, once the document	
20	once there are two signatures on the document,	
21	either party can as long as we get it, either	
22	party can submit it.	
23	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: Okay, sounds	
24	good.	
25	I just, in the past, that we've done	

1	these over the past years, so we've always	
2	submitted. So, I was just wondering.	
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, any	
4	other questions?	
5	(NO AUDIBLE RESPONSE)	
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, good	
7	luck with your negotiation.	
8	And as I said before, if this matter	
9	is not settled, February 7th, if you need more	
10	time, just let us know and we will grant it if	
11	the parties truly believe this matter will be	
12	settled. Okay?	
13	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: Thank you,	
14	Chairman Anderson.	
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.	
16	You're very welcome, ma'am.	
17	Thank you.	
18	All right, thank you very much, have	
19	a great day.	
20	COMMISSIONER COURNIOTES: You, too.	
21	Bye-bye.
