2 This is Downtown Liquors.

3 The Offer in compromise states as
4 follows: Charge one, sale to minor. Statutory
5 authority D.C. Official Code Section 25781, there
6 will be a fine of \$3,000 payable within 90 days,
7 or the license shall be suspended indefinitely
8 until the fine has been paid.

9 Number two, there's a suspension. The
10 license shall be suspended for ten days, with
11 four days to be served January 25th, 2021 through
12 January 28th, 2021, and six days to be stated for
13 one year provided that there are no further
14 violations in this time.

15 In addition, respondent shall serve
16 five days suspensions from February 21st, 2021,
17 through February 25th, 2021, which were activated
18 from Case # 19-CC-00057.

19 Term number three. All employees who
20 serve alcoholic beverages in the licensed
21 establishment, must complete an alcohol training
22 program within three months from the date of this
23 OIC. Is there a second?

24 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis will

16 License No. 087032. The licensee requests
17 cancellation. Wine and Friends, License No.
18 112538. Licensee requests cancellation. And
19 World Market, License No. 072611. Licensee
20 requests cancellation.

21 I make a motion that ABC Board cancels
22 the licenses of all the establishments that I
23 just read in the record, based on the fact that
24 the licensee requested cancellation. Is there a
25 second?

1 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
3 seconded the motion. We will now have roll call
4 to vote on the motion that's been properly
5 seconded by Mr. Short. Mr. Short?

6 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

8 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

10 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I
11 agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

13 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I agree.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson,
15 I agree. The matter passes 5-0-0.

16 We now move to our docket. Our docket
17 is a request from establishments for changes to
18 their license application. There are 11 licensee
19 on the docket today. I will read the name of the
20 licensee. I will also read the category and the
21 request.

22 MS. ANDREWS: It seems as though the
23 Chair is having some technical difficulties.

24 Everyone, please stand by.

25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I'm

1 back. Am I back online?

2 MS. ANDREWS: Yes, Mr. Chair. We can
3 hear you, but we can't see you just yet.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I
5 turned my video back on. I don't know what
6 happened. Hold on. For some strange -- can you
7 hear me?

8 MS. ANDREWS: Yes, we can hear you.

9 MEMBER CROCKETT: Yes, we can hear
10 you.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I
12 don't know, I also -- I'm turning my video on.
13 It's, okay, there it is. I don't know what
14 happened. Maybe I lost the connection for -- I
15 am not sure the last, I believe that prior to
16 being frozen, I said number nine was a request
17 from Marriott at Metro Center, License No. 117 --

18 MEMBER CROCKETT: Oh, no. Mr.
19 Anderson, we never made it through the docket at
20 all.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So where --

22 MEMBER CROCKETT: We're on number one
23 of the docket.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So
25 let me, you know, I apologize.

1 MEMBER CROCKETT: No, it's okay.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I am not
3 looking, I'm reading from the form, so I did not
4 realize that I was not online until I looked, and
5 I heard a click. So let me start us back on the
6 -- I'm sorry.

7 MEMBER CROCKETT: You made it through
8 your introduction and that was the end of it. So
9 we're back on number one, Breakthru Beverage.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. You
11 know, as I tell everyone, when I'm doing this on
12 the video, I'm so into what I'm doing so I'm not
13 looking on the screen to realize I was frozen for
14 whatever reason. And I wasn't even paying
15 attention to my cell phone because someone
16 normally texts me.

17 So if you see me looking at my cell
18 phone, it's not because I'm receiving personal
19 messages. It's because someone from the agency
20 is texting me to keep me on point.

21 And I should say that our IT person
22 did text me, but I was just so into reviewing
23 what I'm doing, I didn't even see my cell phone,
24 that I need to respond. So I apologize.

25 So let's start back at the beginning

1 on our docket. So there are 11 cases on our
2 docket and are docket are requests that are being
3 made by a licensee to make some type of changes
4 to their license.

5 So let me now, let me go back to the
6 beginning of our docket. So the first request on
7 our docket is a request made from Breakthru
8 Beverage, License No. 60518. It is a wholesaler.
9 A, it's a gift and loan application, which is
10 their requesting a guitar presenter.

11 The second request on our docket is a
12 request made from Breakthru Beverage, License No.
13 60518. This is a gift and loan application.
14 They are requesting tabletop propane patio
15 heater.

16 The next request is a request, again,
17 made by Breakthru Beverage, License No. 60518.
18 Again, gift and loan application, bottle service
19 bucket.

20 The next request, a request made
21 again, from Breakthru Beverage, License No.
22 60518. Again, gift and loan application of slim
23 bottle service kit.

24 The next request is being made by
25 Generator, License No. 111618. It is a change of

1 officer application to add Bernard J. Campbell as
2 third vice president and secretary.

3 The next request is a request made by
4 AB Liquors, License No. 117666. They are a
5 retailer. A, transfer without sale application.

6 The next request is being made by
7 Uncorked, License No. 108135. They're retailer
8 A, stock transfer application safekeeping.

9 The next request, request number
10 eight, is a request from Royal Sonesta,
11 Washington D.C., License No. 117665. This is
12 again, they're a retailer, C hotel, transfer
13 without sale application.

14 The next request is being made by
15 Metro -- Marriott at Metro Center, License No.
16 117396. They are a retailer, B 25 percent, new
17 ABC license application.

18 The next request, a request made by
19 Cambria Hotel, Washington D.C., License No.
20 117331. They are requesting -- they're a
21 retailer, B 25 percent. New ABC license
22 application.

23 And the final request is a request
24 made by City State Brewing Company, License No.
25 117581. They are a manufacturer B, and this is a

1 new ABC license application.

2 I therefore make a motion that all the
3 requests made by the licensees on our docket be
4 approved. Is there a second?

5 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett
6 seconds.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett
8 has seconded. Ms. Crockett has seconded the
9 motion. We'll now have a roll call vote on the
10 motion that has been properly seconded by Ms.
11 Crockett. Mr. Short?

12 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

14 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

16 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I
17 agree.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

19 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson,
21 I agree. The matter passes 7-(sic)0-0.

22 We have now come to the end of our
23 scheduled business for the day, and if there's no
24 further questions, I will now close the record
25 officially.

1 As Chairperson of the Alcohol Beverage
2 Control Board for the District of Columbia, in
3 accordance with Title 3, Chapter 405, Office of
4 Open Government, I move that ABC Board hold a

18 vote on the motion before us that has been
19 properly seconded by Mr. Short. Mr. Short?

20 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

22 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

24 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I
25 agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

2 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I agree.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson,

4 I agree. As it appears that the motion has

5 passed, I hereby give notice that the ABC Board

6 will hold this aforementioned closed meeting
