MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you, everyone, for participating in ABRA's roll call hearings via the Webex platform provided by the DC Office of Open Government. My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'll be conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. There is one case on the calendar today. This is the matter of Tom's Watch Bar, Case Number 23-PRO-000102, TWB DC Navy Yard, 1215 Half Street SE, License Number ABRA-119393. This is a Retailer Class C restaurant for a substantial change for an entertainment endorsement inside of the premises. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is anyone present on behalf of the applicant?

MR. MIXON: Cameron Mixon on behalf of the applicant.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Mixon. Mr. Mixon, would you spell your name for the record, please?

MR. MIXON: C-A-M-E-R-O-N, M-I-X-O-N.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
2 Is anyone present on behalf of the protestant?

3 MR. DANIELS: Hi, Ms. Fletcher.
4 Edward Daniels, Chair of ANC 8F. Edward, E-D-W-
5 A-R-D, Daniels, D-A-N-I-E-L-S.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much,
7 Mr. Daniels. ANC 8F does have standing as a
8 protestant. We need to set some dates. I'm
9 going to provide you with a date for the status
10 and the protest hearing following of the roll
11 call hearing. I don't have that -- those dates
12 available at this moment, but I will momentarily.

13 So we're going to go ahead and
14 schedule the mediation. I'll give you the next
15 available day. The next available day is
16 Thursday, January 25, anytime between 10:30 and
17 1:30. That's Thursday, January 25. Does that
18 work for you, Mr. Mixon?

19 MR. MIXON: I believe so. I'm just
20 confirming that there's no other applicant
21 hearings for that day.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

23 MR. MIXON: Later would be better, if
24 not, 12:30 or 1:30.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. What about you,

1 Mr. Daniels?

2 MR. DANIELS: Anytime that day works
3 for me.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, Mr. Mixon,
5 whatever time works for you is going to be it.

6 MR. MIXON: We'll just say 1:30?

7 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, 1:30. Mediation
8 is scheduled for Thursday, January 25 at 1:30. I
9 will send you the Webex invitation to attend the
10 mediation shortly along with the date of the
11 upcoming status and protest hearing.

12 MR. MIXON: Okay.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, that's
14 everything unless you have any questions about
15 anything.

16 MR. DANIELS: Yes. Ms. Fletcher, yes.
17 So we have a draft CA that we are working on with
18 the applicant and hopefully, we'll have that
19 finalized by the end of the week or before next
20 Tuesday before our business meeting. We
21 anticipate withdrawing the protest on Tuesday,
22 the 23rd, once we get through that business
23 meeting that evening. And if we do withdraw,
24 we'll get that letter over to you that evening.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. That's perfect.

1 And then you know what happens next. I cancel
2 the mediation and that's it. The agreement that
3 you submit will go forward to the Board for
4 review.

5 MR. DANIELS: Thank you.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Daniels.
7 So just keep me posted. I'll make a note that
8 this matter may settle prior to the mediation.

9 MR. DANIELS: Okay. Thank you.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you
11 for coming.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Happy New
13 Year to you.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Happy New Year to you.
15 I'm going to say good-bye. Bye, Mr. Mixon.

16 MR. MIXON: Bye. Have a good one.
17 See you again, soon.

18 MS. FLETCHER: You sure will. Thank
19 you. The roll call hearings for today have
20 concluded.
