MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And now we're ready. Good morning everyone. Thank you for participating in ABCA's public roll call hearings being provided via the WebEx platform, via the Office of Open Government.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearings as the Board's agent. There are three cases on the calendar today.

The first case on the calendar is 1922 Lounge, Case Number 24-PRO-00002, Dawit, LLC, 1922 9th Street Northwest, License Number ABRA-126827. This is a Retailer Class CT new license application.

Is anyone present on behalf of 1922 Lounge?

MR. JACKSON: Jeff Jackson present for 1922 Lounge.

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Jackson, would you spell your name for the record, please?

MR. JACKSON: Yes. J-E-F-F first name, J-A-C-K-S-O-N last name.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Is anyone present on behalf of the Westminster Neighborhood

1 Association?

2 MR. CHAUVIN: Yes. This is Frank
3 Chauvin. Frank and C-H-A-U-V- as in Victor I-N.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Chauvin.
5 The Westminster Neighborhood Association does
6 have standing as a protestant.

7 We need to schedule some dates for
8 mediation, a status hearing, and a protest
9 hearing. I will give you the dates for the
10 status and protest hearing first.

11 The status hearing is scheduled for
12 February 28, 2024, at 10:30 a.m. The protest
13 hearing is set for March 13, 2024, at 1:30.

14 I will give you the next available
15 date for mediation. The next available date for
16 mediation is -- well, we can actually do February
17 5 at 11:30, if that's good for anyone. That's a
18 Monday at 11:30.

19 MR. JACKSON: Yes. That's perfect.

20 MR. CHAUVIN: I'd like to move it out
21 to the following week, if that's possible?

22 MS. FLETCHER: That is --

23 MR. JACKSON: Well, I'll be gone the
24 first, I'll be out of the country the first two
25 weeks in February.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

2 MR. JACKSON: And, I won't be back
3 until like the last two weeks, I'll be available.

4 MS. FLETCHER: And so, Mr. Jackson,
5 you'll become available the week of February 19?

6 MR. JACKSON: Yes. That Monday.

7 MS. FLETCHER: What about Tuesday,
8 February 20, any time between 10:30 and 1:30?

9 MR. CHAUVIN: 10:30 would be fine.

10 MS. FLETCHER: 10:30, okay.

11 MR. CHAUVIN: If that works for Mr.
12 Jackson.

13 MR. JACKSON: tentatively, I can.
14 But, it would be more like maybe noon.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Well, if you would
16 prefer noon, Mr. Jackson, and that works for Mr.
17 Chauvin, we can just make it noon.

18 MR. CHAUVIN: Yes. That's fine.

19 MR. JACKSON: Okay. Perfect.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Then mediation is set
21 for noon on Tuesday, January 20. And, I'll send
22 you out the WebEx invite for the mediation.

23 Any questions at all?

24 MR. JACKSON: No. Mr. Chauvin, could
25 you give me a call later on today and we can

1 discuss possibly how can we resolve this matter?

2 MR. CHAUVIN: I'm not available today.

3 But, tomorrow we can do that.

4 MR. JACKSON: That's fine. Anytime
5 tomorrow, just give me a call.

6 MR. CHAUVIN: I will do that.

7 MR. JACKSON: Okay. Thank you.

8 MR. CHAUVIN: Thank you, sir.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you.
10 And, if the matter is resolved in some way, just
11 let me know. And, I will cancel the mediation.

12 MR. JACKSON: Okay.

13 MR. CHAUVIN: Thank you.

14 MR. JACKSON: Thank you.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you
16 very much. The roll call hearing in this matter
17 is concluded.

18 MR. JACKSON: Thank you.

19 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.
