8	application. The protest issues in this case are
9	adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet and
10	residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian
11	safety.

14	MS. LALOR: Yes. I'm here on behalf
15	of the Applicant.
16	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. If you could
17	state your name and spell it for the record,
18	please?
19	MS. LALOR: Yes, gladly. Blair Lalor,
20	B-L-A-I-R, last name L-A-L-O-R.
21	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, Ms. Lalor. Is
22	anyone present on behalf of ANC 6C?
23	(No response.)
24	MS. FLETCHER: Is anyone present on
25	behalf of ANC 6C?

1 (No response.) 2 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Lalor, have you had 3 any communication with ANC 6C? I was under the assumption 4 MS. LALOR: 5 that we had actually already reached a settlement agreement, as I sat down with Michael Upright 6 7 there. 8 MS. FLETCHER: Um-hum. 9 MS. LALOR: And, we did go through a full settlement agreement. And, they said they 10 11 would be, the ANC would be submitting it to ABRA. 12 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you 13 for that. I'll make a note of that. For the 14 purpose of the roll call hearing, the application 15 is dismissed, because the Applicant is not 16 present today. What that means, Ms. Lalor, is that a 17 18 Board Order is issued dismissing the application. 19 And, you'll receive a copy of that. 20 If the Applicant seeks reinstatement, 21 you'll receive a copy of that and have an 2.2 opportunity to respond to that as well. And, the 23 Board would decide whether or not to reinstate 2.4 the application.

That's the process for dismissal of

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1	the application. But, based on what you're			
2	saying, the parties expect to submit a settlement			
3	agreement?			
4	MS. LALOR: That is correct. We did			
5	go through and write one out and both signed off			
6	on it.			
7	MS. FLETCHER: Okay.			
8	MS. LALOR: I do also have a copy of			
9	it. So, I can also submit it to ABRA if			
10	necessary.			
11	MS. FLETCHER: Upon receipt of that,			
12	the Board will review it. If the Board approves			
13	the settlement agreement, there will not be a			
14	dismissal process.			
15	MS. LALOR: Understood.			
16	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, Ms. Lalor

18	MS. LALOR: Should I send this too?			
19	MS. FLETCHER: You should send it to			
20	our general counsel. Her name is Martha Jenkins.			
21	That's spelled M-A-R-T-H-A.Jenkins, spelled J-E-			
22	N-K-I-N-S, Martha.Jenkins@dc.gov.			
23	And, I've made a note that it's			
24	coming. And, I'll let Ms. Jenkins know.			
25	MS. LALOR: Thank you so much. I'll			

1	get that over to her today.			
2	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you			
3	very much for coming.			
4	MS. LALOR: No problem.			
5	MS. FLETCHER: The roll call hearing			
6	in this matter is concluded. Thank you.			
7	MS. LALOR: Have a great rest of your			
8	day.			
9	MS. FLETCHER: Yep. We're done.			
10	There are no more cases on the calendar today.			
11	Roll call hearings for today are concluded.
