7	the rights of Mr. Thomas Martin, please. I'm not
8	sure if the licensee will be there but I know
9	that Mr. Thomas Martin is the attorney in this
10	case.
11	MS. ANDREWS: Sure. Stand by.
12	Mr. Martin, your rights have been
13	elevated.
14	Ms. Glasgow, your rights have been
15	elevated.
16	That's all, Mr. Chair.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
18	Mr. Martin, can you please unmute your
19	microphone and if you have a camera, please open
20	your camera, please. Thank you, Mr. Martin.
21	Oh, Mr. Grandis, Board Member Grandis,
22	is recusing himself from participating in this
23	case.
24	Can the parties introduce themselves
25	for the record. Let's start with the government,

1 please. 2 MR. LUI: Good afternoon, Mr. 3 Chairperson. My name is John Lui, L-U-I, for the District of Columbia. 4 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Martin, can you please identify yourself for the record, 6 7 please. 8 MR. MARTIN: Good afternoon, Mr. 9 Chairperson. My name is Thomas Martin 10 representing Ching, doing business as Uproar. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon, 12 Mr. Martin. This matter was scheduled for a show 13 cause hearing. Are there any preliminary matters 14 before we get started? Do you have a preliminary 15 matter you want to bring to the attention of the 16 Board, Mr. Martin? 17 My dog will start Yes. MR. MARTIN: 18 barking. I think I will be joined by Mr. Lui in 19 requesting a continuance of the hearing to a date 20 to be set by the Board. 21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Martin, why 22 are you requesting a continue of this matter? 23 MR. MARTIN: Well, as the Board may 24 recall, we have a pending protest hearing matter 25 that we are attempting still to work out with the

ANC and we would request additional time to try to work out those matters and possibly settle the current one.

well, Mr. Martin, I don't really understand what a protest matter has to do with a show cause hearing. And I -- it is -- this matter is scheduled for -- your client was on notice as early as January 6th that this hearing was scheduled for today.

It's only my understanding that you made an appearance to this agency on January 21st to inform us that you were now representing this establishment in the show cause hearing. Now, you have known since January -- at least since January 21st that this hearing was scheduled for today and I don't understand why is it at the last minute that the Board is now being told -- a request has been made to continue this matter.

I see that Ms. Glasgow is on the line so it appears that the government was ready to move forward because there is -- I know we're in COVID. There is an employee who had to come into the office today to testify at this hearing so I don't understand why is it that the Board is

being told at the appointed hour that this request is being made.

MR. MARTIN: Well, we've been working in good faith as late as yesterday with the government to try to see what we can do as far as potentially settling. At this point we haven't done that but we would just ask for some additional amount of time to see if we can make that happen.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Lui, the impression I got from Mr. Martin, he stated that the government consents to this extension of time, this continuance?

MR. LUI: Yes, Mr. Chairperson. The government -- the District of Columbia will consent to this extension of time.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Let's go to Mr.

Martin. The Board is not -- as I stated, your

client was on notice as far as January 21st. You

were on notice on January 27th -- January 21st

about this hearing. The Board -- there's a

witness that I see who is online who is in the

office who has been working remotely.

If the parties had the curtesy to have told the Board that they were requesting a

continuance, then we would not have had to have 1 2 an employee of the Agency come to work today who 3 has been working remotely during this period of 4 time so I do not appreciate this last minute extension -- continuance. 5 But as a professional curtesy, I will 6 7 -- all right. Let me ask, would the parties be 8 available for a hearing on February 21st -- I'm 9 sorry, on February 24th at 1:30? Is that a date that could work for both the Government and Mr. 10 11 Lui? 12 I'm checking now. MR. MARTIN: Just 13 a moment. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Sure. 15 MR. MARTIN: I'm checking my calendar. 16 February 24th would be available for us. 17 MR. LUI: Mr. Chairperson, yes. The 18 Government will be available on February 24th at 19 1:30 p.m. Thank you. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 21 Thank you. 22 With that said, then I make a motion that the Board will, therefore -- I make a motion 23 24 that the Board continue this matter to February

24th at 1:30. Is there a second?

22	Anderson, I agree. The matter passes 4-2 with
23	Mr. Short and Ms. Crockett in disagreement
24	As you see, both Mr. Lui and Mr.
25	Martin, the Board is not was not necessarily

inclined. As Chair as a professional courtesy to attorneys, I voted not because I wanted to grant it, but I vote as a professional courtesy to grant the courtesy to attorneys. I would hope that during this period of time as you have stated that you are discussing settlement that the parties -- if this matter can be settled and the parties can settle it and we can do a paper OIC that can be on our legal agenda.

I just want to let you know that if the matter -- if the parties are serious about settling this matter, it can be settled as an agenda item and that we don't need to have another hearing. That's something that a decision can be made long before the 24th.

Anyway, thank you for your appearance today and have a great day.
