CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning everyone. As Chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the District of Columbia I am welcoming you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.

17	Unmute your microphone, Mr. Grandis.			
18	MEMBER GRANDIS: Good morning. Ed

20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The Board has			
21	five members in attendance for the conduct of			
22	business today and that constitutes a quorum.			
23	Before we get underway with today's			
24	hearing calendar, I need to make a few			
25	instructions very clear so that the conduct of			

these hearings is understood by everyone.

There are five cases on this morning's calendar. Once your case is called, I will take a moment for our IT specialist to elevate the rights for each party to enable their camera and microphone. Then, and only then, will you have the ability to enable your equipment.

19	MS. ANDREWS: He's trying to log in			
20	now.			
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay, fine.			
22	Thank you.			
23	MS. ANDREWS: Once he logs in I'll			
24	elevate his status.			
25	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

25	will provide you a Korean interpreter. If you're					

not on the call at 10:00, I'm going to dismiss 1 2 the protest. 3 That's for you, Mr. Adofo. This is at 4 10:00. Yes, sir. Go ahead. 5 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: I apologize for 6 the confusion. My question earlier was myself 7 and the licensee wanted to extend our mediation 8 so I was asking would that be possible if he 9 hadn't showed up because when we did have the 10 mediation, we agreed to continue. 11 We didn't work it all out in that one 12 meeting so I was under the impression that we could continue it and we didn't have to have this 13 14 meeting. I apologize for the confusion. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 16 Thank you for the clarification, sir. Do you 17 have the information -- do you have Ms. Randall's information? 18 19 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Yes, sir. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 21 Speak to Ms. Randall. 22 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: All right. Thank 23 you. 24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: She will let 25 you know if you guys -- if you guys are close to

a settlement agreement, and if you want to postpone it, you can talk to Ms. Randall. She will give you some direction what to do.

COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Yes, sir. I apologize. I didn't mean for the Board to come together. I apologize. Also, I have a hearing on February 4th for another license.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Speak to Ms. Randall. We will provide -- also, if the licensee -- if there's an issue with communication, and if you need a translation service, speak to our agency. We will also provide him a translator so you can communicate with him in these sessions. Okay?

COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Yes, sir.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Speak to Ms.

Randall. She will let us know. If both parties are not available on the 4th, then we will postpone it but you have to tell the agency. If you have any questions, since you've been in communication with April Randall, speak to her. She will guide you. You cannot just show up because if you did not show up this morning, I was going to dismiss your protest.

April Randall, she is your -- she is --6 7 she will work with you. Whatever questions that 8 you have, ask her. 9 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Okay. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: She will walk 10 11 you through the process. She will walk the 12 licensee through the process. This is not -- our 13 agency is here to assist both sides. We are also 14 having a series of training. Are you a new ANC 15 commissioner? 16 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: No, sir. This is 17 my second time. I've done the training. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, we're 19 having some training coming up. We're having 20 three trainings coming up shortly. You need to 21 participate in that. I think Sarah Fauschbaum, I 22 believe, also does that. She is also your 23 contact. 24 COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Yes, sir. 25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do you have her

12	Fauschbaum and you also have April Randall and we			
13	will work with you to make sure you have a smooth			
14	process. Okay?			
15	COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Yes, sir.			
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.			
17	Thank you very much.			
18	COMMISSIONER ADOFO: Thank you.			
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Have a great			
20	day. Thanks.
