The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson presiding.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I'm
4 going to do our agenda items, and then yeah. The
5 first agenda is our legal agenda for alcoholic
6 beverages, and the first matter in our legal
7 agenda is a review of an offer in compromise in
8 lieu of a hearing, dated January 24, 2024 for
9 Case Number 23-CMP-00070, 23-CMP-00080, excuse
10 me, and Case Number 23-CMP-00108, the Lane Social
11 Club, License Number 121348. This is the offer
12 in compromise for Case Number 23-CMP-00070.

13 Charge 1, allowed the establishment to
14 be used for unlawful purposes, statutory
15 authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(2). The
16 fine, the licensee shall either pay a \$1,000 fine
17 or voluntarily surrender its license within 30
18 days. If the licensee fails to do so, its
19 license should be suspended indefinitely until
20 the fine has been paid.

21 Charge 2, failed to keep kitchen open
22 two hours before closing, statutory authority,
23 D.C. Code Section 25-113(b)(1). There's a
24 warning for this charge. Case Number 23-CMP-
25 00080. Charge 1, extended hours of operation

1 without approval, statutory authority, D.C. Code
2 Section 25-762(a) and (b)(13). There's a fine of
3 \$1,000, there's a \$1,000 fine or voluntarily
4 surrender its license within 30 days. If the
5 licensee fails to do so, its license shall be
6 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
7 paid.

8 Charge 2, produce loud music heard in
9 premises other than the establishment, statutory
10 authority, D.C. Code Section 25-725(a)(1), there
11 is a fine of \$250, or voluntarily surrender its
12 license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to
13 do so, the license will be suspended indefinitely
14 until the fine is paid.

15 Charge 3, operated as summer garden
16 without endorsement. Statutory authority, D.C.
17 Code Section 25-113.01(c), fine. The licensee
18 shall either pay a \$1,000 fine or voluntarily
19 surrender its license within 30 days. If the
20 licensee fails to do so, its license shall be
21 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
22 paid.

23 Case Number 23-CMP-00108, Charge 1,
24 extended hours of operation without approval.
25 Statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-762(a)

1 and (b)(13), a fine. The licensee shall either
2 pay a \$1,000 fine or voluntarily surrender its
3 license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to
4 do so, its license shall be suspended
5 indefinitely until the fine is paid.

6 Charge 2, made false or misleading
7 statements with the intention of influencing,
8 impeding, or obstructing an investigation.
9 Statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
10 823(a)(5)(C). Outcome, the licensee shall either
11 pay a \$1,000 fine or voluntarily surrenders its
12 license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to
13 do so, its license shall be suspended
14 indefinitely until the fine is paid.

15 I therefore make a motion that the
16 offer in compromise be accepted. Is there a
17 second?

18 MEMBER GRANT: I second the motion.
