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The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson presiding.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I'm going to do our agenda items, and then yeah. The first agenda is our legal agenda for alcoholic beverages, and the first matter in our legal agenda is a review of an offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing, dated January 24, 2024 for Case Number 23-CMP-00070, 23-CMP-00080, excuse me, and Case Number 23-CMP-00108, the Lane Social Club, License Number 121348. This is the offer in compromise for Case Number 23-CMP-00070.

Charge 1, allowed the establishment to be used for unlawful purposes, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(2). The fine, the licensee shall either pay a $\$ 1,000$ fine or voluntarily surrender its license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to do so, its license should be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge 2, failed to keep kitchen open two hours before closing, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-113(b)(1). There's a warning for this charge. Case Number 23-CMP00080. Charge 1, extended hours of operation
without approval, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-762(a) and (b)(13). There's a fine of \$1,000, there's a \$1,000 fine or voluntarily surrender its license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to do so, its license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge 2, produce loud music heard in premises other than the establishment, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-725(a)(1), there is a fine of $\$ 250$, or voluntarily surrender its license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to do so, the license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

Charge 3, operated as summer garden without endorsement. Statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-113.01(c), fine. The licensee shall either pay a $\$ 1,000$ fine or voluntarily surrender its license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to do so, its license shall be suspended definitely until the fine has been paid.

Case Number 23-CMP-00108, Charge 1, extended hours of operation without approval. Statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-762(a)
and (b)(13), a fine. The licensee shall either pay a \$1,000 fine or voluntarily surrender its license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to do so, its license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

Charge 2, made false or misleading statements with the intention of influencing, impeding, or obstructing an investigation. Statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25823(a)(5)(C). Outcome, the licensee shall either pay a $\$ 1,000$ fine or voluntarily surrenders its license within 30 days. If the licensee fails to do so, its license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.
