3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case  
4 on our calendar is Case Number 23-CMP-00057,  
5 Glassey, License Number 117346. Mr. Orellana,  
6 can you please elevate the rights of the licensee  
7 in the Glassey case, please?

8 MR. ORELLANA: Taj Sohal, your access  
9 has been elevated. That is all, Chair.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Can  
11 you turn your camera on? Can you unmute yourself  
12 and turn your camera on? Yes, ma'am, do you have  
13 a camera you can turn on?

14 MS. SOHAL: I'm actually in the car  
15 right now.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr.  
17 Southcott, can you identify yourself for the  
18 record, please?

19 MR. SOUTHCOTT: Good morning. This is  
20 Chris Southcott, first name, C-H-R-I-S, last name  
21 S-O-U-T-H-C-O-T-T, from DC's Office of the  
22 Attorney General representing the District.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
24 Mr. Southcott. Ms. Sohal, can you please spell  
25 and state your name for the record and identify

1 your relationship to this establishment?

2 MS. SOHAL: Yes. I am the owner of  
3 the business, and my name is Taj Sohal. That is  
4 spelled T-A-J, first name, and S-O-H-A-L, last  
5 name.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Mr.  
7 Southcott, are there any preliminary matters in  
8 this case?

9 MR. SOUTHCOTT: Nothing from the  
10 Government.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Then  
12 hearing that this matter then is scheduled for a  
13 show cause hearing on March 6 at 10:30 a.m.

14 At a show cause hearing, the parties  
15 are required to exchange documents and witnesses,  
16 meaning, Ms. Sohal, if you are contesting the  
17 charge, you need to exchange the documents and  
18 witnesses you are going to call at the hearing.  
19 That needs to be done seven days before the  
20 hearing. You provide a copy of that to the  
21 Government, and you also provide a copy to the  
22 Agency.

23 Failure by either side to exchange  
24 documents and witnesses seven days prior to the  
25 hearing unless reasonable cause is shown, the

1 Board is empowered to prevent that party from  
2 relying on documents and witnesses that have not  
3 been disclosed.

4 Any questions, ma'am?

5 MS. SOHAL: No, sir.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

7 Hearing none, then we will see you on March 6 at  
8 10:30 a.m. Have a great day. Thank you. All  
9 right then. Bye-bye.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. We  
11 have a fact finding hearing. Is the next case  
12 yours, Mr. Southcott?

13 MR. SOUTHCOTT: Not the fact finding  
14 hearing.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, but I'm  
16 talking --

17 MR. SOUTHCOTT: The case after that.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Very good.  
19 Then you can log off because this fact finding  
20 hearing might take a minute and then you can log  
21 back on after for us to do that show cause  
22 hearing. Okay?

23 MR. SOUTHCOTT: Thank you, Mr. Chair.
