Before we get underway with today's hearing calendar, I need to make a few instructions very clear so that the conduct of these hearings is understood by everyone.

There are seven cases scheduled for this morning's calendar. Once your case is called, I will take a moment for our IT specialist to elevate the rights for each party to enable their camera and microphone.

We now turn to our Protest Hearing

1 Status calendar. Our first case on our Protest 2 Hearing Status calendar is Case No. 22-PRO-00117, 3 the Dirty Goose, License No. 101299. Good morning, Mr. Orellana. Can you 4 5 please elevate the rights of the licensee, the licensee representative, and the ANC in this 6 7 case, please. 8 MR. ORELLANA: Richard Bianco, your access has been elevated. 9 Sabel Harris, your access has been elevated. 10 That appears to be 11 all, Chairman. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning. 13 Mr. Bianco, can you please spell and state your 14 name for the record, please. 15 MR. BIANCO: Sure. My name is Richard 16 Bianco, R-I-C-H-A-R-D B-I-A-N-C-O. I represent 17 the Applicant in this matter. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr. Bianco. 19 20 Good morning, Ms. Harris. Can you 21 please spell and state your name for the record, 2.2 please. 23 MS. HARRIS: My name is Sabel Harris, S-A-B-E-L H-A-R-R-I-S. I am a Commissioner on 2.4 25 ANC 1B.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning. 2 Mr. Bianco, are there any preliminary 3 issues on your part? Not exactly. So we had 4 MR. BIANCO: a mediation scheduled in this case. The ANC 5 didn't appear. We haven't heard from them with 6 7 respect to rescheduling but we are willing a able 8 to mediate this matter if they so inclined and 9 would just ask that they reach out to Ms. Fletcher to reschedule so we can get a date on 10 11 the books before the protest hearing. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Harris, are 13 there any matters you want to bring to the attention of the Board? 14 MS. HARRIS: We are very willing to 15 16 reschedule the mediation. There just was 17 redistricting and we had a new commissioner join 18 I spoke with him this morning and he the SMD. would like to reschedule mediation and to work on 19 20 a settlement agreement. That is in process right 21 now. 2.2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you for 23 that. 2.4 The Board supports mediation and the 25 Board supports settlement. If the parties are

genuinely going to settle this matter, let the Agency know as quickly as possible so we do not schedule an investigator on this matter. If you are generally going to settle the matter, let the Agency know so we don't have to assign an investigator to do a report.

Again, we support that. The Agency will ensure that another mediation will be scheduled and hopefully that will bring it towards settlement. This matter is not settled. It is scheduled for a hearing on March 1, 2023 at 1:30 p.m.

Are you familiar, Ms. Harris, with the protest procedures if this matter goes to a protest hearing, or do you want me to read that?

MS. HARRIS: Yes, I am.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I would like to remind the parties if this matter goes for a protest hearing, seven days prior to the hearing both parties are required to submit a PIP. On that PIP you are required to disclose the documents and witnesses that you would rely upon if this matter goes to a hearing.

Failure on the part of either side to disclose a document -- I'm sorry, a PIP, the

Board is empowered to prevent that party from relying on documents and witnesses who have not been disclosed to each side seven days prior to the hearing.

I also want to let you know that if this matter goes to a hearing, each side is allocated one hour to present their case and you will only have four witnesses that you can rely on.

Again, if the parties believe this matter will be settled, good luck with your settlement and please inform the Agency as quickly as possible that this matter will be settled. Again, good luck with your discussions and have a great day. Thank you very much.
