3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in

7 ABRA-089932. This is a Retailer Class B Grocery,
8 application for to renew the license.

9 Is anyone present on behalf of King

24 ABC Board will issue an order dismissing the
25 license renewal application because the applicant

1 did not appear for the roll call hearing today.
2 Upon receipt of that order, the applicant will
3 have ten days to seek reinstatement of the
4 application explaining to the Board the reason
5 they were not present today.

6 You will receive a copy of the order.
7 If the applicant seeks reinstatement, you will
8 have an opportunity to respond to that as well.

9 MS. WHITE: Yes, ma'am. Will I need
10 to submit another protest if they do
11 reinstatement again?

12 MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry, Ms. White.
13 What was the question?

14 MS. WHITE: I said will I need to send
15 in another letter if they do --

16 MS. FLETCHER: No, not at all. So at
17 this point, we'll just be keeping you informed of
18 what's going on. And if the Board reinstates the
19 application, then I'll contact you to set up a
20 mediation.

21 MS. WHITE: Okay, thank you.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you
23 very much. Any other questions, Ms. White?

24 MS. WHITE: That's it, Ms. Fletcher.
25 Thank you.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, then I
2 will see you soon.

3 MS. WHITE: Okay. Have a good rest of
4 your day.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, all right. I'm
6 going to conclude this roll call hearing. Feel
7 free to stay on the line if you'd like. It's a
8 public hearing. Otherwise, I'll see you soon.
