3 MS. FLETCHER: I'd like to thank
4 everyone for joining ABRA's Roll Call Hearings
5 via Webex online. I'm going to wait a couple
6 more minutes to give one party, to the King
7 Convenience Store to appear before we get
8 started.

9 MR. HOLMES: Good morning, Ms.
10 Fletcher, can you hear me?

11 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, who's speaking?

12 MR. HOLMES: This is Commissioner
13 Holmes.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, good morning, Mr.
15 Holmes.

16 I'm going to go ahead and move to the
17 second case on the calendar. I'm calling King
18 Convenience Store. This is case number 21-PRO-
19 00006, Addis Incorporated, 1535 U Street SE,
20 license number ABRA-089932. This is a Retailer
21 Class B Grocery, application to renew the
22 license.

23 Who's present on behalf of New Seven
24 Market? Mr. Lee?

25 MR. LEE: Are you there?

1 MS. FLETCHER: Hi. Are you present on
2 behalf of New Seven Market?

3 MR. LEE: Yes.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Is Mr. Park
5 going to join you today?

6 MR. LEE: No. I'm the attorney for it
7 so that's enough for you, right? Yes.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, it is. Thank you.
9 And present on behalf of ANC 8A?

10 MS. WHITE: Hi, I'm Commissioner
11 Jamila White.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. White.

13 Mr. Lee, let me go back to you. Can
14 you spell your name for the record, please?

15 MR. LEE: Yes. My last name is L-E-E,
16 first name K-Y-U-N-G-H-W-A-N.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
18 And, Ms. White?

19 MS. WHITE: J-A-M-I-L-A, W-H-I-T-E.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

21 ANC 8A does have standing as a
22 protestant. We need to set a date for mediation.
23 The next available day. The next available day
24 for mediation is Wednesday, February 10 at pretty
25 much anytime in the morning up until 2 o'clock in

1 the afternoon.

2 MR. LEE: I prefer 11 o'clock.

3 MS. FLETCHER: What was that Mr. Lee?

4 MR. LEE: 11 o'clock?

5 MS. FLETCHER: 11 o'clock is good on
6 this end. Is that okay for you, Ms. White?

7 MS. WHITE: I have to facilitate a
8 workshop that day. I prefer another day if you
9 have it, maybe the following week?

10 MS. FLETCHER: We can do February
11 11th.

12 MR. LEE: No, it's all booked for me,
13 so it's not available.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, I'll just keep
15 moving. No problem.

16 MR. LEE: I have things on that day so
17 that's just too much. All right, thanks.

18 MS. FLETCHER: No problem at all.
19 What about February 12th?

20 MR. LEE: Friday?

21 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

22 MR. LEE: I'm okay with that.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. White?

24 MS. WHITE: I have another workshop
25 I'm -- that week is my facilitation week. Would

1 you have anything on the 15th?

2 MS. FLETCHER: The 15th, is that a
3 holiday?

4 MR. LEE: Yes, it's, on my calendar
5 it's red so that means a holiday.

6 MS. WHITE: It's President's Day.

7 MS. FLETCHER: What about the 16th?
8 We can do any day that week that's not the 15th
9 then.

10 MS. WHITE: The 16th works best for
11 me.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Is 11 o'clock still a
13 good time?

14 MS. WHITE: Yes, that's fine for me.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Is that okay for you,
16 Mr. Lee?

17 MR. LEE: Which day?

18 MS. FLETCHER: Tuesday, February 16.

19 MR. LEE: Okay. Tuesday, February --
20 yes, okay.

21 MS. FLETCHER: At 11. Is that still
22 good?

23 MR. LEE: Yes.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mediation is
25 scheduled for Tuesday, February 16 at 11. I

1 don't have any other dates to give you today, but
2 you'll receive the dates of the status and
3 protest hearings at a later date.

4 MR. LEE: Okay. So I'm just making
5 sure that it's the 16th at 11 o'clock for
6 mediation for New Seven Market, right?

7 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

8 MR. LEE: All right, thank you.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, then any
10 questions at all? I'll send you a Webex
11 invitation to attend the mediation as well.

12 MR. LEE: Okay. I was just wondering
13 to Ms. White, just for ANC 8A?

14 MS. FLETCHER: That's the only
15 protestant.

16 MR. LEE: Okay. Okay. I think
17 that's because it's a letter named by Dorcas
18 Agyei. So --

19 MS. WHITE: She's my predecessor.

20 MR. LEE: Okay.

21 MS. WHITE: She was my predecessor.
22 We had elections in November.

23 MR. LEE: Oh, okay. So it switched to
24 you?

25 MS. WHITE: Yes, so it switched to me

1 in January.

2 MR. LEE: Oh, that's great. Okay.

3 That's good. Yes.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Well, thank you for
5 coming. Mr. Lee, I'll see you on the 11th.

6 MR. LEE: Yes.

7 MS. FLETCHER: This roll call hearing
8 is concluded. But, Ms. White, you have one more?

9 MS. WHITE: Yes, ma'am.

10 MS. FLETCHER: You can stay on the
11 line. I'll call your next case.

12 MS. WHITE: Okay, thank you.

13 MR. LEE: So I'm done?

14 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, you're done, Mr.
15 Lee.

16 MR. LEE: All right, thank you very
17 much. Be safe.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. All right.

19 MR. LEE: All right.

20 MS. FLETCHER: You too.
