MR. LUTES: Yes. So the Offer in Compromise, Charge 1, no ABC manager on duty, violation of DC Code Section 25701. The Offer in Compromise since it is a first secondary tier violation would be a \$250 fine payable within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

Ms. Mayberry, it's my understanding there is an Offer in Compromise that the Licensee pays a fine \$250 payable within 30 days. If the fine is not paid within 30 days, the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid. Is this your understanding of the Offer in Compromise, ma'am?
