2 MR. JORDAN: Of course, James Jordan
3 on behalf of the District, that's J-A-M-E-S
4 J-O-R-D-A-N.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, good
6 morning. The Licensee is not here. This matter
7 then is scheduled for a show cause hearing on
8 March 2nd, 2022, at 1:30 p.m.

9 And, Mr. Jordan, if there is an
10 agreement between the parties, they can send us a
11 paper OIC prior to the hearing. So you can let
12 your colleague know that if the parties have
13 decided to settle this matter, they can provide
14 the Board an offer-in-compromise in writing. And
15 we can discuss it on our legal agenda. All
16 right?

17 MR. JORDAN: Yes, sir.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
