3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

4 Good afternoon, everyone. We're back on the
5 record. Before we get -- yeah, back on the
6 record. I would like to say hello to everyone
7 who are joining us for the first time this
8 afternoon.

9 My name is Donovan Anderson. I'm
10 Chairman of the Board. Joining us today are five
11 other Board members. The five Board members who
12 are joining us today is Mr. James Short, Mr.
13 Bobby Cato, Ms. Rema Wahabzadah, Ms. Jeni Hansen,
14 and Mr. Edward Grandis. The Board has six
15 members for the attendance -- in attendance
16 today, and that constitutes a quorum to conduct
17 business.

18 Before we get underway with this
19 afternoon's calendar, I need to make a few
20 instructions very clear so that the conduct of
21 these hearings is understood by everyone. We
22 have two protest hearings this afternoon, one
23 protest hearing that starts at 1:30 and another
24 one that's scheduled start at 3:30. It's not
25 going to start at 3:30 unless we just fly through

1 this. But we're going to try to move this along
2 as quickly as possible so we can have two
3 productive hearings today.

4 So this is what's going to occur.
5 Once your case is called, I will take a moment
6 for our IT specialist to elevate the rights for
7 each party to enable their camera and microphone.
8 Then and only then will you have the ability to
9 enable your equipment.

10 If your is not being heard, you will
11 remain mute and your camera will be disabled. At
12 the conclusion of each case, the parties will
13 have the option to leave. If the party choose to
14 stay, all cameras and microphones for the
15 concluded case will be disabled. Should you have

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

21 Anderson, I agree. The matter therefore passes
22 6-0-0. Thank you to the Board members for that.
