3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case		
4	on our calendar is Case No. 20-PRO-00055, Charles		
5	Corner, License No. 094783.		
6	Ms. Andrews, can you please elevate		
7	the rights of the protestants and the licensee in		
8	this case, please?		
9	MS. ANDREWS: Sure. Ms. Akinseye, I'm		
10	sorry if I'm mispronouncing it. Your rights have		
11	elevated. That's it, Mr. Chair.		
12	MS. AKINSEYE: Good morning.		
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,		
14	ma'am.		
15	(Pause.)		
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're waiting		
17	for the licensee.		
18	(Pause.)		
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And while we're		
20	waiting, ma'am, can you introduce yourself for		
21	the record, please? I don't know		
22	MS. AKINSEYE: Sure. Good morning,		
23	everyone. My name is Victoria Akinseye. I am		
24	the Commissioner for Single-Member District 8C in		
25	Ward 8. Pretty much at this time we are still		

currently working on a settlement agreement.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, so you've been in contact with the licensee?

MS. AKINSEYE: Yes, my colleague,
Salim Adofo has, not me personally but -- and
they are still working on a settlement agreement.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Have you guys been to mediation, do you know?

MS. AKINSEYE: Well, we had a mediation the day of inauguration which was January 20th.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Right.

MS. AKINSEYE: And we had -- it was almost three hours. And we agreed that we would work with Charles Corner store to come to some type of agreement on how we can reduce some of the issues with the liquor store that we are having.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. I will just -- since he's not here, I was just trying to find out if there's been communication between the parties. That's all. All right. So we'll just continue. I'll wait a couple more minutes, and I'll make a decision on what we're going to do.

MS. AKINSEYE: Okay.

(Pause.)

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I don't know where the licensee is. Normally if a licensee does not show up or a party doesn't show up, we will dismiss -- we would dismiss the application.

MS. AKINSEYE: Okay.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Based on the representation that you have made, you're saying that the parties are discussing a settlement. So do you believe that the parties will come to a -- will sign a settlement agreement? Is it your hope? Do you believe that this would occur?

MS. AKINSEYE: That is the hope and the goal, I mean, obviously. But I don't -- I mean, I don't know. I mean, ultimately, we will hope to try and settle.

But at this point, I can't really say what direction it's going to go at this point. I just know that the residents within the community do not want the -- does not want Charles Corner store to sell liquor because of the chaos, crime, and assaults that have been happening within the community, loitering, the illegal dumping of trash within that community. The residents don't

want liquor being sold.

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CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Give me a minute, please.

MS. AKINSEYE: Okay.

(Pause.)

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. This matter was scheduled for a protest hearing status -- this matter was -- hold on. All right. All right. This matter was scheduled for a protest status hearing today. It was scheduled for 10:00 o'clock. The licensee was notified of the date and time of the status hearing. And it has always been the position and policy of the Agency that if a party does not show -- does not appear at a protest -- if a party does not appear at either mediation -- I'm sorry, roll call or -excuse me, or here at the status hearing or at the protest hearing, if a party does not appear, we will either dismiss the protest or we will dismiss the application for renewal or the application for whatever change that's been made. So the protestant is here.

The renewal of the application has been made by ANC 8C, and the protestant is here.

The licensee after being provided the proper

notice by the Agency has still not appeared. And we have waited almost half an hour since this hearing was scheduled for 10:00 o'clock, and it's almost 10:30. And the protestant had -- I'm sorry, the licensee has not appeared.

When we were meeting in person, it was my -- it had always -- what I usually did is that I would call the case because we usually took the bench at 9:30. I would call the case at 9:30.

And if the person was not there at 9:30, I would give them a half an hour grace period and recall the case at 10:00 o'clock.

And so if the person did not appear within that half an hour grace period, then I would make a motion to dismiss the matter. Here it is that we are participating virtually, this hearing was scheduled for 10:00 o'clock. It is now 10:30.

I've provided the licensee a half an hour grace period as the licensee has appeared for this hearing. With that said, I am then going to make a motion that the ABC Board dismiss the license application. Once the Board votes on this dismissal, the licensee will have ten days to appeal this decision to provide the Board with

reasonable notice why he failed to appear today. 1 If he does not -- if the Board is not 2 3 convinced by his response -- by the licensee's 4 response why he did not appear today, then the 5 renewal application will be dismissed and then he will have to start the process over. So anyway, 6 7 with that said, I then make a motion that the 8 renewal application be dismissed based on the 9 failure of the licensee to appear this morning. 10 Is there a second? 11 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has second the motion. We'll now have a roll call 13 14 vote on the motion that has been properly second 15 by Mr. Short. Mr. Short? 16 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree. 17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? 18 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Wahabzadah? 20 MEMBER WAHABZADAH: Rema Wahabzadah, 21 I agree. 22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? 23 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree. 24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? 25 (No audible response.)

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis is not there. Mr. Anderson, I agree. The matter therefore passed 5-0-0. So the Board will dismiss the renewal application based on the failure of the licensee to appear today.

The licensee will have -- once the written order is issued, the licensee will have ten days to appeal the decision to give the Board reasonable notice -- reasonable cause why he failed to appear today. If that's not done, then the application is dismissed. All right. Thank you very much, ma'am, for your appearance today.

MS. AKINSEYE: You guys have a great day. Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And you have a great day. Thank you very much.

MS. AKINSEYE: Bye.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The Board then will be in -- this then ends our morning calendar, and the Board will be in recess until our 1:30 hearing this afternoon. I just want to remind Board members that they need to log on to our executive session at 1:15. However, we will reconvene for a public session at 1:30.

So I will see the public at 1:30 for
