7	The protest issues are adverse impact
8	on peace, order and quiet, residential parking
9	and vehicular and pedestrian safety.
10	My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting
11	the roll call hearing as the Board's Agent.
12	Introductions beginning with the Applicant,
13	please.
14	MR. ANDARGIE: Henock Andargie from
15	Treehouse.
16	MS. FLETCHER: And, Mr. Andargie, can
17	you please spell your name for the record?
18	MR. ANDARGIE: Yes. It's, first name
19	is Henock, H-E-N-O-C-K, last name is Andargie, A-
20	N-D-A-R-G-I-E.
21	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
22	And
23	MR. BLANCHARD: Lyle Blanchard of
24	Greenstein, DeLorme and Luchs, Counsel for the
25	Applicant.

	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Blanchard, would
2	you please spell your name for the record?
3	MR. BLANCHARD: Certainly. First name
4	is Lyle, L-Y-L-E; last name is Blanchard, B-L-A-
5	N-C-H-A-R-D.
6	MS. FLETCHER: And, Mr. Blanchard,
7	could you spell the name of your firm?
8	MR. BLANCHARD: Okay. So it's three
9	names. It's Greenstein, G-R-E-E-N-S-T-E-I-N,
10	DeLorme, D-E-L-O-R-M-E, and Luchs, which is, L-U-
11	C-H-S.
12	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
13	And present on behalf of ANC 1C?
14	MR. BOWLES: Good morning. It's Japer
15	Bowles, he, him, his. And that's J-A-P-E-R, B-O-
16	W-L-E-S. On behalf of ANC 1C.
17	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And present
18	on behalf of the Kalorama Citizens Association?
19	MR. JAMES: Hi. Denis James. D-E-N-
20	I-S, J-A-M-E-S.
21	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. ANC 1C and
22	the Kalorama Citizens Association have standing
23	as Protestants.
24	We need to set a date for mediation.
25	I'll give you the next available day. The next

1	available day is Wednesday, February 10.
2	If that's too soon for anybody then we
3	can look at dates the following week.
4	MR. JAMES: Yes, that's a little too
5	soon for me.
6	MS. FLETCHER: What about the 17th.
7	That's next Wednesday. Anytime in the morning
8	will
9	(Simultaneous speaking.)
10	MR. JAMES: It seems I'm the only one
11	saying anything. How about 1:00 p.m. on that
12	date, if that date is okay with the others?
13	MS. FLETCHER: That works on this end.
14	MR. BOWLES: Yes, that will work for
15	us as well.
16	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And, Mr.
17	Blanchard, that works for you and your Client as
18	well?
19	MR. BLANCHARD: I wanted to hear from
20	Mr. Andargie. It works for my calendar, but I
21	haven't
22	MR. ANDARGIE: Yes.
23	MS. FLETCHER: Oh, Mr. Andargie. Mr.
24	Andargie, that works for you too?
25	MR. ANDARGIE: Yes.

1	MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for
2	Wednesday, February 17 at 1 o'clock. And I'll
3	send you a WebEx invitation to attend.
4	Any questions at all? Okay. Well,
5	then, I'll see you then.
6	MR. ANDARGIE: All right, thank you.
7	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for
8	participating.
9	MR. JAMES: Thank you very much.
10	MR. BLANCHARD: Ms. Fletcher?
11	MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
12	MR. BLANCHARD: Can I ask a question
13	please?
14	MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
15	MR. BLANCHARD: So you've set the
