3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The first agenda
4 that we will do is our legal agenda alcohol. The
5 first, number one in the agenda, it's an offer in
6 compromise in Case Number 25-CMP -- Case Number 25-
7 CMP-00090. And the offer in compromise is as follows.

8 Charge 1, operated outside of approved
9 hours, first primary tier violation. Statutory
10 authority D.C. Code Section 25-762(a) and (b)(13), the
11 term \$1,000 to be paid within 30 days or the license
12 shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has
13 been paid.

14 Charge 2, expanded operations to allow --
15 to another floor without approval, first statutory
16 authority D.C. Code Section 25-762(a) and (b)(3).
17 There is a \$1,000 fine to be paid within 30 days or
18 the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the
19 fine is paid.

20 Charge 3, no ABC manager on duty,
21 statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-701. There
22 is a \$250 fine to be paid within 30 days or the
23 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine
24 has been paid.

25 I therefore make a motion that the offer
in compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

1 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I second the
2 motion.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
4 seconded the motion, we'll have a roll call vote. Mr.
5 Grant?

6 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

8 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn, I agree.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

17 CMP-00080, Bonjon, B-O-N-J-O-N, Rumi, R-U-M-I, License
18 Number 129636. And the offer in compromise is as
19 follows.

20 Charge 1, failed to follow the settlement
21 agreement, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-
22 823. There is a fine, there is a \$250 fine to be paid
23 within 30 days of the Board accepting the offer in
24 compromise, and if the payment is not made in 30 days,
25 their license will be suspended indefinitely until
payment is received.

1 Charge 2, offer entertainment without
2 endorsement, License Number 25-762. There is a fine
3 of \$1,000 to be paid within 30 days of the Board
4 accepting the offer in compromise. If payment is not
5 made within 30 days, the license will be suspended
6 until the payment is made.

7 I therefore make a motion that the offer
8 in compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

9 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn, I second.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn has
11 seconded the motion, we'll have a roll call vote. Mr.
12 Grant?

13 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree.

24 Foods Market Group, License Number 109870. The offer
25 in compromise is as follows. Charge 1, sale to minor,
D.C. Code Section 25-781. There is a fine of \$2,000

1 paid within 30 days of the Board accepting the offer
2 in compromise. If payment is not made within 30 days,
3 their license will be suspended indefinitely until
4 payment is made.

5 There's a suspension. The license will be
6 suspended for five days, with all five days stayed for
7 one year of the terms. All the employees who serve
8 alcoholic beverages in the licensed establishment
9 shall complete an alcohol training program within
10 three months from the OIC's date.

11 I therefore make a motion that the offer
12 in compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

13 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows, I second.

9 in compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

16 motion that we approve this agreement. Is there a

agenda, review of an offer in compromise, this is in

1 Case Number 26-ULC-00085, excuse me. It's Potomac
2 Tobacco. Number 1, the OIC terms as follows.
3 Products not to be offered, exchanged, or sold.
4 Respondent confirms that it has ceased selling
5 cannabis or cannabis products.

6 Respondent and all beneficial owners,
7 heirs, and assigns agree not to sell the following at
8 the premises, online, or any other location in
9 District of Columbia. Number 1, flavored tobacco;
10 number 2, cannabis and cannabis products, including
11 all cannabinoids, hemp, CBD, tetrahydrocannabinolic
12 acid, THC-A, and THC without a medical cannabis retail
13 license.

14 Three, kratom; 4, any Schedule I
15 substance, including psychedelic mushrooms and DMT.
16 Number 2, inspection. Respondent agrees to allow ABCA
17 investigators to inspect the entire premises of the
18 business during those hours that it is open to the
19 public to verify that the business is not selling
20 those products listed in paragraph 1.

21 Three, future violations. This summary
22 closure constitutes the first violation of D.C. Code
23 Section 7-1671.08(f), such if respondent has not filed
24 an accepted and pending application with the ABC Board
25 and knowingly engages or attempts to engage in the
purchase, sale, exchange, delivery, or any other form

1 of commercial transaction involving cannabis in the
2 future, the ABC Board may issue a \$20,000 fine under
3 D.C. Code Section 7-1671.08(f)(2).

4 Four, fine. Respondent agrees to pay a
5 \$10,000 fine for this violation. Respondent shall
6 contact ABCA.legal@DC.gov to coordinate payment of the
7 fine.

8 Number 5, lifting of the summary closure.
9 Upon payment of the fine, the summary closure shall be
10 lifted.

11 I therefore make a motion that the offer
12 in compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

13 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn, I second.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn has

15 Number 3, review application for a class
16 change from a retailer Class D restaurant to a
17 retailer Class C restaurant. This is for Spicy Water,
18 License Number 125456. Recommendation: placard.

19 Number 4, review application for streatery
20 endorsement with 28 seats, this is for Service Bar,
21 License Number 103008. Recommendation: placard.

22 Number 5, review application for streatery
23 endorsement with 20 seats, this is for Mikko Nordic
24 Fine Food, License Number 109951. Recommendation:
25 placard.

Number 6, review application for game of

1 skill license and endorsement to install five machines
2 offering the approved game, District Edge by
3 Pace-o-Matic. This is Muni, M-U-N-I, License Number
4 124594, recommendation approval.

5 Number 7, review application for game of
6 skill license and endorsement to install five machines
7 offering the approved game, District Edge by
8 Pace-o-Matic. This is for Crab Plug Seafood Bar &
9 Grill, License Number 118192, recommendation approval.

10 Number 8, review application for the
11 carryout and delivery endorsement, this is for Allure
12 Lounge, License Number 108303, recommendation
13 approval.

14 And number 9, review a request for
15 approval to provide a gift of sweet treats that
16 doesn't exceed \$500 in value to various licensed
17 retail establishments. The request has been made by
18 Breakthru Beverage, License Number 124554.
19 Recommendation: approval.

20 I therefore make a motion that the offer
21 in compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

17 Recommendation: placard.

18 Number 6, review application for
19 streatory endorsement with 24 seats, this is for
20 Jaleo, J-A-L-E-O, License Number 121497.
21 Recommendation: placard.

22 Number 7, review application for sports
23 wagering endorsement to install up to three seats of
24 sports wagering terminals in the main floor and bar,
25 this is Allure Lounge, License Number 108303.
Recommendation: placard.

 Number 8, review a request to reclassify

1 the approved sidewalk cafe as part of the approved
2 summer garden space based on the certificate of
3 occupancy. This is for Alero Union Market, License
4 Number 132427. Recommendation: approval.

24 This matter is a retroactive -- they're
25 asking for retroactive -- the Agency's asking for
retroactive approval.

1 Number 9 is a request from Joseph
2 Respress, R-E-S-P-R-E-S-S for a one-day license
3 Class F. There was a fundraiser, this event was
4 held February the 7th. The License Number is
5 135151, there were 80 attendees, two security
6 guards, and the recommendation's approval.

21 I agree. The matter passes 5-0.
