The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4 calendar is DC Smoke. This is Case No. 24-PRO-
5 00009, UND Necessities LLC, 727 D Street NW,
6 License No. ABRA-126787. This is a Retailer
7 Class MC for a new medical cannabis application.
8 The protest issues are adverse impact on peace,
9 order, and quiet.

10 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting
11 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is
12 anyone present on behalf of DC Smoke?

13 MR. LEE: Only me.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Did I hear someone say
15 something?

16 MR. LEE: I think that was me.

17 MS. FLETCHER: So I can't hear you
18 very well.

19 MR. LEE: Can you hear me now?

20 MS. FLETCHER: Is this Mr. Lee
21 speaking?

22 MR. LEE: That's right.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Lee, could
24 you spell your name for the record, please?

25 MR. LEE: T-H-O-M-A-S S. L-E-E.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

2 ANC 2C does have standing as a
3 protestant. Is anyone present on behalf of DC
4 Smoke?

5 Mr. Lee, I'm going to recall this case
6 in just a few minutes. The person representing
7 the Applicant in this case is the same one
8 representing the Applicant in the previous case
9 so I'm allowing another two or three minutes for
10 that person to appear.

11 MR. LEE: Okay. Sounds Good.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Just sit tight for a
13 minute.

14 MR. LEE: Okay. I was just grabbing
15 my phone. I heard it ringing in the background.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.

17 MR. LEE: I can still hear you.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

19 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter went
20 off the record at 10:08 a.m. and resumed at 10:13
21 a.m.)

22 MS. FLETCHER: I'm call in the next
23 case on the calendar which is DC Smoke, Case No.
24 24-PRO-00009. Is anyone present on behalf of the
25 Applicant, DC Smoke?

1 The time is approximately 10:15 and
2 there's no one present on behalf of DC Smoke.
3 Therefore, the application is dismissed.

4 Mr. Lee, are you still there?

5 MR. LEE: I'm here, yes.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. The
7 application is dismissed because there's no one
8 present on behalf of the Applicant at this time.

9 MR. LEE: Okay.

10 MS. FLETCHER: A Board order will be
11 issued dismissing the application for the reason
12 that's been stated. The ANC will receive a copy
13 of the Board order. If the Applicant seeks
14 reinstatement of the application, you'll be
15 informed and have an opportunity to respond.

16 MR. LEE: Okay. Understood. Is there
17 a deadline for when they might be able to seek
18 re-application or it can be whenever?

19 MS. FLETCHER: Well, the Board order
20 has to be issued first. In the Board order it
21 gives you guidelines for when to seek -- the time
22 frame, I mean, within which to seek a
23 reinstatement, but you'll have a copy of the
24 Board order so you will know when that is.

25 MR. LEE: Thank you very much.

1 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.

2 MR. LEE: Okay.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for coming.

4 MR. LEE: Thank you.

5 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.

6 The roll call hearing in this matter
7 is concluded.
