The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: Well, I'd like to say good morning, and thank you for participating in ABRA's roll call hearings via the WebEx platform provided by the D.C. Office of Open Government. There is one case on the calendar today, this is the matter of Sports \& Social, case number 23-PRO-00010, S\&S U Street, LLC., 1314 U Street Northwest, license number ABRA-12318.

This is a retailer class CR new license application. My name is Laverne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the board's agent. The protest issues in this matter are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet. Is anyone present on behalf of Sports \& Social?

MS. DUNSMORE: Good morning Ms. Fletcher, my name is Jamie Dunsmore, I'm the corporate paralegal for Live! Hospitality \& Entertainment.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you Ms. Dunsmore. And Ms. Dunsmore, are you going to be the designated representative going forward?

MS. DUNSMORE: It will be myself, and our general counsel, Mary McCudden.

MS. FLETCHER: And how do you spell her name?

MS. DUNSMORE: Sure, it's capital M-C capital C-U-D-D-E-N.

MS. FLETCHER: You said M-C-C-U?
MS. DUNSMORE: D-D-E-N.
MS. FLETCHER: McCudden?
MS. DUNSMORE: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: That's her last name?
MS. DUNSMORE: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: What's her first name?
MS. DUNSMORE: Mary.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And so we're going to need some contact information for whichever one of you we should send WebEx invitations to.

MS. DUNSMORE: Yes ma'am, I do know my information is on the application, but I'll be more than happy to --

MS. FLETCHER: Whichever you prefer.
MS. DUNSMORE: We'll go with mine, that's fine.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So, Ms. Dunsmore, can you say your email address?

MS. DUNSMORE: Sure, it's J-D as in
dog, $\mathrm{U}-\mathrm{N}$ as in Nancy, S as in sam, M-O-R-E @cordish, C-O-R-D-I-S-H .com.

MS. FLETCHER: That's J-D-U-N-S-M-O-R$E$, that's the spelling of your last name, Dunsmore?

MS. DUNSMORE: Yes ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: At what again?
MS. DUNSMORE: Cordish, C-O-R-D-I-S-H .com.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Dunsmore, you're talking a little fast for me this morning.

MS. DUNSMORE: Sorry, sure. It's Cordish --

MS. FLETCHER: Cordish?
MS. DUNSMORE: Yeah, C-O-R-D-I-S-H.
MS. FLETCHER: C-O-R-D-I-S-H.
MS. DUNSMORE: Yes ma'am, dot com.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so I have jdunsmore@cordish.com, Cordish is spelled C-O-R-D-I-S-H .com?

MS. DUNSMORE: That's correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Dunsmore, do you have a telephone number where we can reach you?

MS. DUNSMORE: I do, it's 4103472753.
MS. FLETCHER: 410347275?

MS. DUNSMORE: Three.
MS. FLETCHER: Three?
MS. DUNSMORE: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very much. And present on behalf of ANC 1B?

MS. HARRIS: Hi, this is Sabel Harris, S-A-B as in boy, E-L H-A-R-R-I-S, and I represent ANC 1 B .

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you Ms. Harris, ANC 1B does have standing as a protestant. Ms. Dunsmore, give me your title one more time?

MS. DUNSMORE: Sure, I'm a corporate paralegal.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very much. We need to set a date for mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing. The status hearing is scheduled for March 15th, 2023 at 10:30 a.m., that's for the status hearing. The protest hearing is set for April the 12th, 2023 at 1:30 p.m. I will give you the next available day for mediation.

The next available day is Tuesday, February 21st, at 1:30 in the afternoon. Or Thursday, February 23rd, anytime between 10:00, and 1:30, those are the next two dates available
actually. So, that's the 21st at 1:30, a Tuesday, or the 23rd, which is a Thursday, anytime between 10:00, and 1:30.

MS. HARRIS: Ms. Fletcher, this is Sabel Harris, the 23rd works better for me, I cannot do the 21st.

MS. DUNSMORE: That works well for me as well Ms. Fletcher.

MS. FLETCHER: Do you have a preference in terms of time, morning, or afternoon?

MS. HARRIS: Anytime, I mean 11:00 works great, but anytime works, I have Thursday open.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Dunsmore, does 11:00 work for you on the 23rd?

MS. DUNSMORE: 11:00 is fine.
MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for Thursday, February 23rd, at 11:00, and I will send you the WebEx invitation to attend the mediation, the WebEx link for the status hearing, and protest hearing comes from someone else on the staff. And Ms. Dunsmore, that's just so that you know.

MS. DUNSMORE: Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: And you'll get the WebEx invite from me.

MS. DUNSMORE: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: And so, Ms. Dunsmore, you have some contact information for me already?

MS. DUNSMORE: I do.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, good, if you need anything, have any questions, just let me know. Okay, well I'd like to thank you for coming, and --

MS. DUNSMORE: Sorry Ms. Fletcher, the only question I have is will the ANC be submitting a settlement statement, or position before the mediation next week?

MS. FLETCHER: That's not a requirement, but sometimes one party will present the other with a draft, and so --

MS. DUNSMORE: Got you, okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Harris, is that what you're expecting to do, or you're just going to get started in mediation?

MS. DUNSMORE: It depends on timing. We do have a template, and I will need to get a look at past templates. I know that we're into a previous space that was occupied by the Smith, so

I will need to look into that. But we can certainly -- we do have a starting place, so we're not starting from nothing.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, all right, Ms.
Dunsmore, does that answer your question?
MS. DUNSMORE: Yes ma'am, thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well thank you for coming. If you think of anything else, just let me know. The roll call hearing in this matter is concluded. Thank you for coming.

MS. DUNSMORE: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome, bye bye.
