try and shorten the presentation as much as possible while keeping it effective. I certainly understand that you want to keep things moving along, but we wanted you to be aware ahead of time that we do perceive a need for some additional time and witnesses.

And that has to do with, in part, the fact that we're representing a group of 70-plus individuals, which is I think a little bit unique. We also have the ANC and the DCCA, possibly a representative of the MPD, and someone for the business community as well as a private investigator.

14 So there are a number of witnesses. 15 We have non-duplicative testimony that we would 16 like to present we think would be helpful for the 17 Board to consider.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes, 19 it's my understanding that this is unopposed? 20 Yes, that's correct. MS. YOHANNES: 21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: It's on our 2.2 legal agenda to vote, but since the parties are 23 here and they're asking a question. So I make a 24 motion that the request be granted. 20	to the hearing, the Board is empowered to prevent				
21	that side from relying on documents and witnesses				
22	that have not been disclosed seven days prior to				
23	the hearing. I just want to make sure that				
24	everyone's aware of that.				
25	The Board has granted an extension in				

1 the sense that, yes, you can have more time to 2 present your case and have more witnesses. So we 3 have granted that. We don't have say it's only limited to an hour. 4 5 But I will remind the parties that if this matter goes to a hearing, because there are 6 7 three protestants and it appears that there might 8 be a lot of witnesses, I would ask that you 9 streamline the testimony by witnesses and we enforce that to have redundant testimony. 10 11 I don't need a witness to say that 12 it's noisy. We all know that if that's the 13 One or two person says that, but I don't issue. 14 need ten people to come in and give the same 15 testimony. 16 So just want to remind all the 17 parties, yes, you're going to have more 18 witnesses, but make sure that each witness who 19 testify that they are not repeating the testimony 20 that was provided by the previous witness. Is 21 that clear to everyone? 2.2 (Pause.) 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Good 24 luck in your mediation. If not, I will see you 25 on March 15th for this hearing. Have a great
