CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We are back on the record to do the Board's agendas for February 18, 2015.

The first item on the Legal Agenda is an amendment to a settlement agreement between ANC-2E and Epicurean and Company dated January 27, 2015. Epicurean and Company is located at 3800 Reservoir Road, N.W., License No. 077576. I move that we approve. Do $I$ have a second?
