The WebEx invitation is going to be sent to you, and 6 7 you can forward it to whichever parties are going 8 to attend the mediation. 9 I have a count here of one, two, three, four, five, six, seven individuals from 10 11 the group present. FLETCHER: Yes. 6 7 MS. VERDI: I am in a Federal trial 8 that starts on the 13th, and it's scheduled to go 9 through the 24th of March in Atlanta. Would it be 10 possible to do the status hearing the following 11 week? MS.
