MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is Union Oyster Bar and Lounge. This is Case No. 23-PRO-00012, Union Oyster Bar and Lounge, 501 Morse Street NE, License No. ABRA 110747. This is a Retailer Class CR License Renewal, protest issues, adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher, conducting the roll hall hearing as the Board's Agent .

Is anyone present on behalf of Union Oyster Bar?

MR. RAO: Yes, my name is Mr. Rao, and Mr. Webster is also present.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Could you please state your name and spell it for the record, please?

MR. RAO: Yeah. My first name is Shyam, S-H-Y-A-M, last name is R-A-O.

MS. FLETCHER: So, let me ask you something. Now, we have your full name spelled out, but you are not using your full name?

MR. RAO: I can use my full name, I can
spell it out.
MS. FLETCHER: Yes, but could you spell your full name?

MR. RAO: Sure Shyamsunder, S-H-Y-A-M-S-U-N-D-E-R, last name Basker, B-A-S-K-E-R R-A0 .

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So, we just have R-A-O as your last name, but you have a middle name as well? So, which one will you use, I just want to make sure that we have it accurate.

MR. RAO: Just use the Mr. Rao as the last name. That's fine.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And, someone else is with you?

MR. WEBSTER: Mr. Webster, what name do you have for me, Ms. Fletcher?

MS. FLETCHER: I don't have a name for you right now.

MR. WEBSTER: Okay. I'm Russell Webster, R-U-S-S-E-L-L, last name Webster, W-E-B-S-T-E-R.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you, Mr. Webster.

Okay. So, let me --
MR. WEBSTER: I'm sorry, you are
welcome.
MS. FLETCHER: So we, so who is going to be the contact person for Union Oyster Bar and Lounge? We have Mr. Rao as the contact person, so is that going to continue to be the case?

MR. WEBSTER: That's correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. Thank you very much.

We have a Group of Five as well. Are the designated representatives present from this group?

MS. MEIJA: Yeah, I just didn't read the five, two of our cases have been grandfathered in, but there's two of us on.

MS. FLETCHER: If you will state your name and spell it for the record, please.

MS. MEIJA: Jessica Meija, J-E-S-S-I-CA, Meija, M as in Mary- E-I-J-A.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And, someone else is present also Ms. Meija?

MS. MEIJA: Yes, Christine Godinez, C-H-R-I-S-T-I-N-E, last name G-O-D-I-N-E-Z.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Godinez, just so that you know, you are breaking up a little, but I did get that spelling. I'll just spell it
again for the record.
MS. MEIJA: Sure. Yeah, my internet is bad today.

MS. FLETCHER: That's okay.
MS. MEIJA: C-H-R-I-S-T-I-N-E, last name G-O-D-I-N-E-Z.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
Anyone else from the group today?
Ms. MEIJA: No.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
There are two of you present today. Therefore, the group is granted conditional standing.

MS. MEIJA: No, Ms. Fletcher. No, I'm speaking just in here. We, our case has been granted for --

MS. FLETCHER: Oh, you were grandfathered in, weren't you?

MS. MEIJA: Yes. Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Thanks for reminding me of that, it's not on the sheet I'm looking at.

Yeah, and so, just for the record you'll put the five that are grandfathered in from the previous roll call hearing where you
were granted standing. And so, you are -- your standing is granted, as grandfathered in. So, there is no requirement that at the upcoming status hearing that you bring an additional three people, just either one of you needs to appear. MS. MEIJA: Okay.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
We need to set a date for mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing. I've give you the dates for the status and protest hearings first.

The status hearing is schedule for March the 22nd, 2023, at 10:30 a.m. The protest hearing is set for May the 3rd, 2023, at 1:30.

I'll give you the next available day for mediation. The next available day is Wednesday, February the 8th, Wednesday February 8th, any time between 10:00 and 1:30.

MR. WEBSTER: February?
MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry, I think I said February. I meant March 8th. March 8th, any time between 10:00 and 1:30.

MR. WEBSTER: You say any time, do we pick that?

MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, any time that's
available, any time that you are available between 10:00 and 1:00. Any time that all parties are available.

So, is anyone available on March 8th?
MR. WEBSTER: We are available at 10:00, whatever works for everyone.

MS. FLETCHER: Who is speaking?
MR. WEBSTER: Should I pronounce this every time I speak?

MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, yes.
MR. WEBSTER: That's no problem
MS. FLETCHER: I should have said that each time so that the court reporter knows who is speaking.

MR. WEBSTER: Okay. This is Russell Webster from Union Oyster Bar.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MR. WEBSTER: 10:00 works for us.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you, Mr.
Webster.
What about the Protestants?
MS. MEIJA: I can't join, but Christine, does that work for you?

MS. GODINEZ: No audible response.
MS. FLETCHER: So, Ms. Meija, did you
just say you can't join?
MS. MEIJA: Sorry, yes, Christine, does that work for you?

MS. GODINEZ: Yes, that's fine. This is Christine Godinez, that's fine. Any of those dates at the moment are fine for Christine Godinez, who is speaking.

MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh.
MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for Wednesday, March 8, at 10:00 a.m. I will send you the WebEx invite to attend that mediation.

MR. WEBSTER: No, not -- Russell
Webster speaking, nothing from me.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Webster.
