22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Andrews, is

24	MS. ANDREWS: He was on the line				
25	earlier, but he's not anymore.				

1 MR. KLINE: Okay, no worries. I'm 2 here for the Applicant. 3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You sure about 4 that, Mr. Kline, we can -- or do you want to take 5 a break for us to find your client? It's up to 6 you. 7 MR. KLINE: No, it's okay. We have an 8 OIC to present, so I don't -- I thought he would 9 be here, and if he is, I would want him on, but 10 if he's not, that's fine. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, 12 Mr. Adams, since Mr. Kline kind of thank you. 13 let the cat out of the bag, so I'm going to act 14 like I am surprised. Let me ask a question that 15 I don't know the answer of. Are there any 16 preliminary matters in this case? 17 Yes, Mr. Chairman, as Mr. MR. ADAMS: 18 Kline has stolen my thunder, there is a 19 preliminary matter in this case. 20 (Simultaneous speaking.) 21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What are the 22 preliminary matters, please? 23 MR. ADAMS: Yes, Mr. Chairman. For 24 the charge in this case, the parties have 25 discussed it and have offered to negotiate a

settlement. We're proposing an offer in 1 2 compromise, in which the establishment receives a 3 written warning to resolve this case. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. 4 Mr. 5 Kline, it's my understanding there is an OIC, and the OIC is that the Government has stated that 6 7 there is a written warning. Is this your 8 understanding of the OIC, sir? 9 Yes, it is, Mr. Chairman. MR. KLINE: 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client 11 aware that by accepting an OIC that they're 12 giving up their right to a hearing? 13 MR. KLINE: Yes. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client 15 also aware that by accepting an OIC that they're 16 giving up their right to appeal this matter? 17 MR. KLINE: Yes. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I make a motion 19 that the offer in compromise of a written warning 20 be accepted. Is there a second? 21 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato seconds. 22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato has 23 seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll call 24 vote on the motion that has been properly
