3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So now that we  
4 have dispensed with our calendar for the day, let  
5 me now go to our Legal Agenda.

6 The first matter on our Legal Agenda  
7 is a review of an Offer in Compromise in Lieu of  
8 a Hearing, dated February 17, 2022. This is for  
9 case number 21-251-00030. This is Rosebar  
10 Lounge, license number 077883.

11 The offer in compromise, there are two  
12 charges allowed the establishment to be used for  
13 disorderly purpose, D.C. Official Code Section  
14 25-823.82. The primary violation and that charge  
15 has been dismissed. The second charge, charge  
16 number two, is a failing to follow security plan,  
17 D.C. Official Section 25-823.86. The fine is a  
18 1,500 dollar fine paid within 120 days or the  
19 license should be suspended indefinitely until  
20 the fine is paid.

21 I make a motion that the board accepts

22 failure of the licensee, they sold alcoholic  
23 beverage to a person under the age of 21. The  
24 statutory authority is D.C. Code Section 25-781  
25 and the term is a warning.

12 license number 014419. This is just an FYI for  
13 the board.

14 Number 10 is a review of the  
15 Suspension of On-premises Alcohol Sales and  
16 Consumption Notice of 18th Emergency Rulemaking.  
17 I'm just going to read a short portion of the  
18 Rulemaking that we're voting on today.

19 On January 11, 2022, Mayor Bowser  
20 issued Mayor' Order 2022-007, which extended the  
21 public emergency declared by Mayor's Order 2020-  
22 045, dated March 11, 2020 to March 17, 2022. The  
23 Mayor's Order also clarifies that the vaccination  
24 entry requirements for persons 12 years of age or  
25 older and by person 18 years of age or older, who

1 are subject to the vaccination entry requirements  
2 would be required to provide proof of identity  
3 with proof of vaccination.

4 Due to the decline of the Omicron  
5 variant and the decrease in COVID-19 cases and  
6 hospitalizations, Mayor Bowser issued Mayor's  
7 Order 2022-029 on February 14, 2022. The Mayor's  
8 Order notifies the public of the end of the  
9 public health emergency, the end of the mask  
10 mandate at certain venues effective March 1,  
11 2022, and the end of the requirement for certain  
12 private venues to check vaccine status effective  
13 February 14, 2022. The Mayor's Order makes clear  
14 that businesses are still permitted to impose  
15 vaccination verification requirements and may not  
16 prohibit their employees from wearing face masks  
17 or coverings.

18 In order to ensure that the District's  
19 Alcoholic Beverage Regulations are consistent  
20 with the mayor's most recent order, the board  
21 finds immediate action is necessary to adopt the  
22 emergency rules. These rules remove two earlier  
23 mandates namely that the employees and patrons of  
24 on-premises ABC licensed establishments must wear  
25 a mask while indoors and that persons who are 12

1 years of age or older show proof of vaccination  
2 prior to entering the licensed premises. The  
3 emergency rulemaking is necessary to provide  
4 licensees with the options to still require that  
5 masks be worn indoors and that patrons provide  
6 proof of vaccination for the purposes of  
7 protecting their employees and the public.

8 Therefore, I make a motion that the  
9 board adopts the suspension of the on-premises  
10 alcoholic sales and consumption notice of 18th  
11 Emergency Rulemaking. These emergency rules will  
12 supercede the emergency rules that the board  
13 adopted on January 12, 2022. These emergency  
14 rules will take effect on March 2, 2022, and will  
15 expire in 120 days or by June 30, 2022, unless  
16 superceded. Is there a second to adopt these  
17 rules?

18 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis will

20 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

22 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
23 agree.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

25 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

2 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
3 agree.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.  
5 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed six-zero-  
6 zero.

7 Number nine, Review a Request to  
8 refund application and annual fees rendered for  
9 the ABC License application which was ultimately  
10 returned to the applicant by the Licensing  
11 Division. This is for House of Wine and Beer,  
12 license number 120374.

13 I make a motion that we approve this  
14 request. Is there a second?

15 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett  
16 seconds.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has  
18 seconded the motion. We will now have a roll  
19 call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

20 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

22 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

24 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
25 agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

2 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

4 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
5 agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.  
7 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed six-zero-  
8 zero.

9 This is an FYI for the public, one of  
10 the reasons why the board voted to return the  
11 fees in this particular case is that they had  
12 tried to apply for a license in an area that such  
13 a license was prohibited by operation of law. So  
14 because such a license could not be offered in  
15 that area, that's the only reason why the board  
16 is returning the licensing fee. As a matter of  
17 course, the board does not refund licensing fees  
18 once they are made to the agency.

19 All right, number 10, is a Review  
20 Request to Remove the Sidewalk Caf, Endorsement  
21 from the license. This is Sansibar Cantina,  
22 license number 117012.

23 I make a motion that we approve this  
24 request. Is there a second?

25 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

1 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I second.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short and  
3 Mr. Grandis have seconded the motion. We will  
4 now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr.  
5 Short?

6 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

8 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

10 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
11 agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

13 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

15 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
16 agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

18 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed six-zero-  
19 zero.

20 We now move to the Board's Temporary  
21 License and One-Day Substantial Change document.  
22 The first request is a request from William  
23 Wiegand. This is for a one-day license Class F.  
24 This is for a St. Patrick's Day celebration.  
25 This is on March 12, 2022. The license number is

1 120610, 200 attendees, working security guards.

2 I make a motion that we approve this  
3 request. Is there a second?

4 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett  
5 seconds.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett  
7 has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll  
8 call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

9 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

11 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

13 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
14 agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

16 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

18 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
19 agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

21 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed six-zero-  
22 zero.

23 Number two is a request from Connor  
24 Dolan for a one-day license Class F. This is for  
25 a wedding. This is May 21, 2022. The license

1 number is 120682, 150 attendees.

2 I make a motion that we approve this  
3 request. Is there a second?

4 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett  
5 seconds.

6 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I second.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett  
8 has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll  
9 call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

10 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

12 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

14 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
15 agree.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

17 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

19 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
20 agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.  
22 Anderson, I agree. The matter passes six-zero-  
23 zero.

24 All right, we now have for the next,  
25 for number three that I'm going to read, number

1 three, number four, number five. These are three  
2 requests made by, I'm going to read the three  
3 requests and then I'm going to make a motion that  
4 the board deny these requests.

5 So the next three requests, number  
6 three is a request from Jesse B. Rauch, a one-day  
7 license Class G. This was for an event on March  
8 16, 2022. The other request is another request  
9 from Jesse B. Rauch, for a one-day license Class  
10 G. This was for an event on March 14, 2022. And  
11 number five, is another request from Jesse B.  
12 Rauch for a one-day license Class G for an event  
13 on March 29, 2022.

14 I make a motion that the ABC Board  
15 denies these three requests. Is there a second?

16 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has  
18 seconded the motion. We will now have a roll  
19 call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

20 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

22 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

24 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
25 agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

2 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

4 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
5 agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.  
7 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed six-zero-  
8 zero. (Pause.)

9 All right, now I'm going to read  
10 number six through 11 on our list. I'm going to  
11 state what request has been made and at the end  
12 of this list, I'm going to ask the ABC Board to  
13 grant these licenses.

14 All right, so number six on the list  
15 is a request from Ian Richardson-Reis for a one-  
16 day license Class G. This is for a wedding on  
17 March 12, 2022. The license number is 1120590,  
18 150 attendees.

19 Number seven on the list is a request  
20 from Richard Diaz for a one-day license Class G.  
21 This is again a wedding on March 5, 2022. The  
22 license number is 120598.

23 Number eight on the list is a request  
24 from Jennifer Currie for a one-day license Class  
25 G. This is the annual Irish Festival. This is

1 on March 19, 2022. The license number is 120615  
2 with 2,500 attendees.

3 Number nine is a request from Griffin  
4 Lahre L-A-H-R-E for a one-day license Class G.  
5 This is a wedding on March 26, 2022. The license  
6 number is 120643.

7 Number 10 was a request from Pearl  
8 Dive Oyster Palace/BlackJack, a one-day  
9 substantial change. This event was scheduled for  
10 February 28, 2022, and for March 1, 2022.  
11 License number is 085382. The substantial change  
12 number is 22SV-00547.

13 Number 11 is another request from  
14 Pearl Dive Oyster Palace/BlackJack, a one-day  
15 substantial change license. The date of the  
16 event was February 26, 2022 and the license  
17 number is 085382. I then make a motion that ABC  
18 Board grant the requests that were just stated  
19 and placed in the record. Is there a second?

20 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett  
21 seconds.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett  
23 has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll  
24 call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

25 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

2 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

4 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I

5 agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

7 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

9 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I

10 agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

12 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed six-zero-

13 zero.

14 Number 12 on the list is a pub crawl,

15 a request from Good Bar Crawl. It's a pub crawl.

16 The date of the event is April 23, 2022. The

17 substantial change license number is 112754. The

18 substantial change number is 22SC-00550. They're

19 asking for us to approve 950 participants to

20 participate in this pub crawl on the U Street

21 Corridor.

22 I make a motion that we grant the

23 request to approve the 950 participants. Is

24 there a second?

25 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I second.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis has  
2 seconded the motion. We will now have a roll  
3 call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

4 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I disagree.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

6 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

8 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
9 agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

11 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

13 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
14 agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

16 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed five to  
17 one.

18 All right, we'll now move to our  
19 Licensing Administrative Docket. On our License  
20 Administrative Docket there are 15 applicants.  
21 I'll review the names of the 15 applicants and at  
22 the end of the list, I will ask that the ABC  
23 Board grant the requests.

24 The first request is a request from  
25 James Dabney Bibb, III. This is for a personal

1 importation permit application. The license  
2 number is 22IMP-00003.

3 The second request is a request from  
4 Kate L. Richardson. This is also for a personal  
5 importation permit applicant. The license number  
6 is 22IMP-00002.

7 Number three is a request from Across  
8 the Pond Restaurant and Pub. License number is  
9 106099. They're a retailer C restaurant. This  
10 is a letter of request to remove Gerald M. Feeney  
11 as a member.

12 Number four is a request from  
13 Mudrick's Supermarket. License number 105822.  
14 They're a retailer B. Class change application  
15 from a Class B license to a Class A license.

16 Number five is a request from Carolina  
17 Bar & Grill. License number 114272. They're a  
18 retailer C restaurant. Change of hours  
19 application.

20 Number six, a request from Chufly  
21 Imports. License number 116875. They're a  
22 retailer internet A transfer to a new location  
23 application from 1701 Florida Avenue, N.W. to  
24 7212 Georgia Avenue, N.W.

25 Number seven, a request from Delia's

1 Catering. License number 103563. This is a  
2 caterer's license to transfer to a new location  
3 application from 626 South Washington Street,  
4 Falls Church, Virginia to 362 West Broad Street,  
5 Falls Church, Virginia.

6 Number eight, a request from Sangria  
7 Bar and Grill. License number 120675. They're a  
8 caterer license. New license application.

9 Number nine, a request from Silver  
10 Diner/Silver Social. License number 120105.  
11 Retailer C restaurant. New ABC license  
12 application.

13 Number 10, a request from Uncle Lee's  
14 Seafood. License number 120654. A retailer A  
15 liquor store transfer with sale of application.

16 Number 11, a request from The River  
17 Inn/Bistro By Butler. License number 120558.  
18 Retailer C hotel transfer without sale  
19 application.

20 Number 12, a request from Sala Thai.  
21 License number 120056. Retailer C restaurant,  
22 new ABC license application.

23 Number 13, a request from Wok and Roll  
24 Bar and Lounge. License number 120606. Retailer  
25 C tavern transfer with sale application.

1                   Number 14, a request from Lunas de  
2 Buenos Aires - Argentinian Street Food. License  
3 number 119215. They're a retailer C restaurant,  
4 new ABC license application.

5                   Number 15, is a request from Andy's  
6 Pizza 18th Street. License number 119705.  
7 They're a retailer C restaurant, new ABC license  
8 application.

9                   I therefore make a motion that the ABC  
10 Board grants these applications. Is there a  
11 second?

12                   MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett  
13 seconds.

14                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett  
15 has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll  
16 call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

17                   MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

18                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

19                   MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

20                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

21                   MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
22 agree.

23                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

24                   MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

25                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

1                   MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
2 agree.

3                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.  
4 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed six-zero-  
5 zero. Thank you very much.

6                   We're now at the end of all of our  
7 agenda items for the day. We have covered all  
8 the calendar for the day, so the board will now  
9 adjourn for the day.

10                  As Chairperson of the Alcoholic  
11 Beverage Control Board for the District of  
12 Columbia, and in accordance with Title 3, Chapter  
13 405 Office of Open Government, I move that the  
14 ABC Board hold a closed meeting on March 9, 2022,  
15 for the purpose of discussing and hearing a  
16 report concerning ongoing or planned  
17 investigations of alleged criminal or civil  
18 misconduct or violation of regulations and  
19 seeking legal advice from our legal counsel on  
20 the board's Investigative Agenda, Legal Agenda  
21 and Licensing Agenda for March 9, 2022, as  
22 published in the D.C. Register on March 4, 2022.  
23 Is there a second?

24                  MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett  
25 seconds.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett  
2 has seconded the motion. I will now take a roll  
3 call vote on the motion before us now that is has  
4 been seconded. Mr. Short?

5 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

7 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

9 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I  
10 agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

12 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

14 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I  
15 agree.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.  
17 Anderson, I agree. As it appears that the motion  
18 has passed six-zero-zero. I hereby give notice  
19 that the ABC Board will hold this aforementioned  
20 closed meeting pursuant to the Open Meetings Act.  
21 Notice will also be posted on the ABC Board's  
22 Bulletin Board, placed on the electronic calendar  
23 on ABRA's website and published in the D.C.  
24 Register in as timely a manner as possible.

25 I would like to thank our ABC Board

1 members and the members of the public who have  
2 signed in/logged in today to participate in this  
3 hearing. Thank you for active participation. We  
4 are now adjourned for the day.

5 I now direct all board members to  
6 return to executive session for further  
7 developments. Have a great afternoon. Thank you  
8 very much.
