CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So now that we have dispensed with our calendar for the day, let me now go to our Legal Agenda.

The first matter on our Legal Agenda is a review of an Offer in Compromise in Lieu of a Hearing, dated February 17, 2022. This is for case number 21-251-00030. This is Rosebar Lounge, license number 077883.

The offer in compromise, there are two charges allowed the establishment to be used for disorderly purpose, D.C. Official Code Section 25-823.82. The primary violation and that charge has been dismissed. The second charge, charge number two, is a failing to follow security plan, D.C. Official Section 25-823.86. The fine is a 1,500 dollar fine paid within 120 days or the license should be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

Number 10 is a review of the Suspension of On-premises Alcohol Sales and Consumption Notice of 18th Emergency Rulemaking. I'm just going to read a short portion of the Rulemaking that we're voting on today.

On January 11, 2022, Mayor Bowser issued Mayor' Order 2022-007, which extended the public emergency declared by Mayor's Order 2020045, dated March 11, 2020 to March 17, 2022. The Mayor's Order also clarifies that the vaccination entry requirements for persons 12 years of age or older and by person 18 years of age or older, who
are subject to the vaccination entry requirements would be required to provide proof of identity with proof of vaccination.

Due to the decline of the Omicron variant and the decrease in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations, Mayor Bowser issued Mayor's Order 2022-029 on February 14, 2022. The Mayor's Order notifies the public of the end of the public health emergency, the end of the mask mandate at certain venues effective March 1, 2022, and the end of the requirement for certain private venues to check vaccine status effective February 14, 2022. The Mayor's Order makes clear that businesses are still permitted to impose vaccination verification requirements and may not prohibit their employees from wearing face masks or coverings.

In order to ensure that the District's Alcoholic Beverage Regulations are consistent with the mayor's most recent order, the board finds immediate action is necessary to adopt the emergency rules. These rules remove two earlier mandates namely that the employees and patrons of on-premises ABC licensed establishments must wear a mask while indoors and that persons who are 12
years of age or older show proof of vaccination prior to entering the licensed premises. The emergency rulemaking is necessary to provide licensees with the options to still require that masks be worn indoors and that patrons provide proof of vaccination for the purposes of protecting their employees and the public.

Therefore, I make a motion that the board adopts the suspension of the on-premises alcoholic sales and consumption notice of 18th Emergency Rulemaking. These emergency rules will supercede the emergency rules that the board adopted on January 12, 2022. These emergency rules will take effect on March 2, 2022, and will expire in 120 days or by June 30, 2022, unless superceded. Is there a second to adopt these rules?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett? MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
Anderson, $I$ agree. The matter passed six-zerozero.

Number two is a request from Connor Dolan for a one-day license Class F. This is for a wedding. This is May 21, 2022. The license
number is 120682, 150 attendees.
I make a motion that we approve this request. Is there a second?

MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett seconds.

MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I second.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?
MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett? MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr. Anderson, $I$ agree. The matter passes six-zerozero.

All right, we now have for the next, for number three that I'm going to read, number
three, number four, number five. These are three requests made by, I'm going to read the three requests and then $I^{\prime \prime m}$ going to make a motion that the board deny these requests.

So the next three requests, number three is a request from Jesse B. Rauch, a one-day license Class G. This was for an event on March 16, 2022. The other request is another request from Jesse B. Rauch, for a one-day license Class G. This was for an event on March 14, 2022. And number five, is another request from Jesse B. Rauch for a one-day license Class G for an event on March 29, 2022.

I make a motion that the ABC Board denies these three requests. Is there a second?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?
MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?
MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
Anderson, $I$ agree. The matter passed six-zerozero. (Pause.)

All right, now I'm going to read number six through 11 on our list. I'm going to state what request has been made and at the end of this list, I'm going to ask the ABC Board to grant these licenses.

All right, so number six on the list is a request from Ian Richardson-Reis for a oneday license Class G. This is for a wedding on March 12, 2022. The license number is 1120590, 150 attendees.

Number seven on the list is a request from Richard Diaz for a one-day license Class G. This is again a wedding on March 5, 2022. The license number is 120598.

Number eight on the list is a request from Jennifer Currie for a one-day license Class G. This is the annual Irish Festival. This is
on March 19, 2022. The license number is 120615 with 2,500 attendees.

Number nine is a request from Griffin Lahre L-A-H-R-E for a one-day license Class G. This is a wedding on March 26, 2022. The license number is 120643.

Number 10 was a request from Pearl Dive Oyster Palace/BlackJack, a one-day substantial change. This event was scheduled for February 28, 2022, and for March 1, 2022. License number is 085382. The substantial change number is 22SV-00547.

Number 11 is another request from Pearl Dive Oyster Palace/BlackJack, a one-day substantial change license. The date of the event was February 26, 2022 and the license number is 085382. I then make a motion that ABC Board grant the requests that were just stated and placed in the record. Is there a second?

MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett
seconds.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett? MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr. Anderson, $I$ agree. The matter passed six-zerozero.

Number 12 on the list is a pub crawl, a request from Good Bar Crawl. It's a pub crawl. The date of the event is April 23, 2022. The substantial change license number is 112754. The substantial change number is 22SC-00550. They're asking for us to approve 950 participants to participate in this pub crawl on the U Street Corridor.

I make a motion that we grant the request to approve the 950 participants. Is there a second?

MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I second.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I disagree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett? MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr. Anderson, I agree. The matter passed five to one.

All right, we'll now move to our Licensing Administrative Docket. On our License Administrative Docket there are 15 applicants. I'll review the names of the 15 applicants and at the end of the list, $I$ will ask that the ABC Board grant the requests.

The first request is a request from James Dabney Bibb, III. This is for a personal
importation permit application. The license number is 22IMP-00003.

The second request is a request from Kate L. Richardson. This is also for a personal importation permit applicant. The license number is 22IMP-00002.

Number three is a request from Across the Pond Restaurant and Pub. License number is 106099. They're a retailer C restaurant. This is a letter of request to remove Gerald M. Feeney as a member.

Number four is a request from Mudrick's Supermarket. License number 105822. They're a retailer B. Class change application from a Class B license to a Class A license.

Number five is a request from Carolina Bar \& Grill. License number 114272. They're a retailer C restaurant. Change of hours application.

Number six, a request from Chufly Imports. License number 116875. They're a retailer internet A transfer to a new location application from 1701 Florida Avenue, N.W. to 7212 Georgia Avenue, N.W.

Number 10, a request from Uncle Lee's Seafood. License number 120654. A retailer A liquor store transfer with sale of application.

Number 11, a request from The River Inn/Bistro By Butler. License number 120558. Retailer C hotel transfer without sale application.

Number 12, a request from Sala Thai. License number 120056. Retailer C restaurant, new ABC license application.

Number 13, a request from Wok and Roll Bar and Lounge. License number 120606. Retailer C tavern transfer with sale application.

Number 14, a request from Lunas de Buenos Aires - Argentinian Street Food. License number 119215. They're a retailer C restaurant, new ABC license application.

I therefore make a motion that the ABC Board grants these applications. Is there a second?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has seconded the motion. We will now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?
MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?
MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?
MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
Anderson, I agree. The matter passed six-zerozero. Thank you very much.

We're now at the end of all of our agenda items for the day. We have covered all the calendar for the day, so the board will now adjourn for the day.

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett? MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr. Anderson, I agree. As it appears that the motion has passed six-zero-zero. I hereby give notice that the ABC Board will hold this aforementioned closed meeting pursuant to the Open Meetings Act. Notice will also be posted on the ABC Board's Bulletin Board, placed on the electronic calendar on ABRA's website and published in the D.C. Register in as timely a manner as possible.
