7 Those are requirements in order for a 8 protest to be considered valid, therefore I'm 9 dismissing the protest filed by ANC 1B. That 10 information has to be in the protest letter, but 11 I'll ask you just so you have an opportunity to 12 respond to that. Was there a properly noticed 13 public hearing?

MS. FIELDS: Yes, there was. The ANC met in February, on February 1, and we voted at our commission meeting, we met with a public hearing.

18 MS. FLETCHER: That information needs 19 to be in the protest letter.
