4	next case on our calendar is Case No. 23-PRO-
5	00094, Marte Bar and Lounge, License No. 125774.
6	Mr. Orellana, can you please elevate
7	the Amharic interpreter, the Licensee, and also
8	the Protestant for this case?
9	MR. ORELLANA: Meskerem Balkew, your
10	access has been elevated.
11	Roxan Kerr, your access has been
12	elevated.
13	Misrak and Karl Kerr, your access has
14	been elevated.
15	Commissioner Courniotes, your access
16	has been elevated.
17	And I believe that's all, Chairman.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Who is the
19	interpreter?
20	MR. ORELLANA: Meskerem Balkew.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Balkew, can
22	you turn your camera on, please? All right. Can
23	you spell and state your name for the record,
24	ma'am?
25	MS. BALKEW: M-E-S-K-E-R-E-M, first

1	name Meskerem, last name B-A-L-K-E-W.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
3	Could you raise your right hand, ma'am? Do you
4	solemnly affirm that you will faithfully and

8	MS. BALKEW: I do.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

L9	All right. Okay. Who is the owner?

21	MS. R. KERR: This is Roxan Kerr
22	speaking. The owner is Misrak and Karl Kerr.
23	And I'm Counsel, Roxan Kerr.
24	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I apologize,
25	ma'am. I was not aware.

1	All right. So we need an Amharic
2	interpreter; is that correct?
3	MS. R. KERR: Well, we will for the
4	hearing. I think today, since there's nothing to
5	report, we probably won't need her for today.
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So you're
7	saying that we I just want to make sure that's
8	on the record. You are Counsel and you're
9	stating that we do not need an interpreter for
0	this protest hearing status today; is that
.1	correct, ma'am?

.3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

-6	your appearance today. You're free to go.
.7	MS. BALKEW: Thank you.
-8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

20	All right. Good morning, Ms. Kerr.
21	Can you please spell and state your name for the
22	record and your representation?
23	MS. R. KERR: Yes. Good morning. My
24	name is Roxan Kerr. And the spelling, first name
25	R-O-X-A-N, last name is K-E-R-R. And I'm Counsel

1	to Misrak and Karl Kerr, Marte Bar and Lounge.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
3	Good morning. Can they spell and state their
4	name for the record?
5	MS. R. KERR: Yes.
6	MS. M. KERR: Yes. This is Misrak
7	Vekele Kerr. It's M-I-S-R-A-K V-E-K-E-L-E, Kerr,
8	K-E-R-R.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
10	ma'am.
11	MS. M. KERR: Good morning.
12	MR. KERR: I'm Karl Kerr, K-A-R-L K-E-
13	R-R.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
15	You both are the owners of the establishment; is
16	that correct?
17	MR. KERR: That's correct.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms.
19	Courniotes, I apologize if I can you please
20	spell and state your
21	MS. COURNIOTES: It's fine. I'm
22	Commissioner Chrysanthe Courniotes, C-H-R-Y-S-A-
23	N-T-H-E C-O-U-R-N-I-O-T-E-S. I'm Commissioner
24	for 4D04. I'm representing our 4D Commission
25	today.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
2	ma'am.
3	MS. COURNIOTES: Good morning.
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Kerr, are
5	there any preliminary matters you want to bring
6	to the attention of the Board?
7	MS. R. KERR: No, sir, there's not.
8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Courniotes,
9	are there any preliminary matters you want to
10	bring to the attention of the Board?
11	MS. COURNIOTES: No, there are not.
12	Thank you.
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
14	Thank you.
15	This matter is scheduled for a protest
16	hearing on April 10th at 1:30 p.m. And let me
17	just read the instructions for the protest
18	hearing.
19	Now that we have scheduled this matter
20	for a protest hearing, there are a few things
21	that I would like to instruct the applicant and
22	the protestants about so that the protest hearing
23	is focused and addresses only those issues that
24	are being protested.
25	The Board does not intend to hear

testimony on matters that are not relevant to this case. You should have received by electronic or regular mail a letter explaining the protest process, a copy of the protest information form, and a copy of the exhibit form. If you do not have these documents, please contact our legal office following this hearing.

It is imperative that you review the rules closely and adhere to them before and during the protest hearing. You're also required to complete and submit the protest information form (PIP) and the exhibit form seven days before the date of the hearing.

These two forms and accompanying documents need to be submitted to ABCA's Legal Division and to all opposing parties in this matter. If we do not receive a copy of your PIP, your application or your protest, whichever side you're representing, may be subject to dismissal.

Likewise, if we do not receive a copy of the exhibit form and the exhibits themselves, your exhibits may be excluded from the record upon a finding that the opposing party has been prejudiced or no good cause for failure to submit has been shown. Likewise, witnesses other than a

party may also be subject to exclusion if not identified on the PIP.

Accordingly, these forms are very important. They greatly assist the Board in narrowing the protest issues, facilitating the process, and keeping the parties on point during the hearing. They likewise provide notice to opposing parties, enabling them to better prepare for the hearing.

As you are aware, all our hearings are now conducted virtually. You will have one hour to present your case, and you will only be allowed to call five witnesses.

If you require more time to present your case and require more than five witnesses, please file a motion with the ABC Board requesting additional time and/or additional witnesses.

We thank you greatly for your cooperation. If you have any questions today or at any time leading up to the hearing, please do not hesitate to contact ABCA's Legal Division.

Any questions before I bring this hearing to a closure?

MS. R. KERR: No, sir. Thank you.

If a 10 settlement agreement can be reached prior to, is 11 there a deadline to submit that? 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'd prefer you 13 provide the Board a settlement agreement as soon 14 as possible. 15 MS. COURNIOTES: Okay. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: If the hearing 17 is scheduled and you have a settlement agreement, 18 I'll accept it. If you truly believe that this 19 case can be settled, you can advise us. 20 I prefer settlements because if 21 there's a settlement agreement, then at least we 2.2 know that the community and the licensee agree on 23 the operation. If the Board has to make a 2.4 decision, then one side might be happy and the

other side will be unhappy.
