CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case on our calendar is a public hearing. It's an emergency and proposed rulemaking for medical cannabis signs and advertisement.

All right. On January 31, 2024, the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board, by a vote of 3-0, adopted emergency and proposed rules related to medical cannabis establishment signage and advertising.

The basis of this action was the passage of the Medical Cannabis Program

Enforcement Emergency Amendment Act of 2024, which became effective January 25, 2024, and which modified various medical cannabis advertising rules.

Based upon the Council's emergency amended legislation, the Board's emergency and proposed rulemaking seeks to:

One, ensure that the existing regulations comply with current law;

Two, clarify how medical cannabis facilities may post signage and be advertised;

Three, establish advertising and

1 signage guidelines as unlicensed operators 2 transition to the legal medical cannabis market; Four, avoid public nuisances; 3 And five, increase awareness of 4 medical cannabis to be used as medicine and 5 treatment by qualifying patients. 6 7 After issuing public notice regarding 8 these rules, the Board scheduled today's hearing 9 to take comments from the general public 10 regarding the proposed rules. ABCA was not 11 notified in advance of the hearing regarding 12 anyone who desired to testify today. 13 Mr. Orellana, is there anyone in the 14 waiting room who wants to testify today regarding 15 this rulemaking? 16 MR. ORELLANA: Only the court reporter 17 is in the waiting area. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank Okay. 19 you. This matter was scheduled for a 20 21 hearing at 10:30. It is now 11:08.
