The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: The last case on the calendar is Buho's Restaurant. This is Case Number Case \#23-PRO-00020, Nunez Property Management, LLC, 3521 14th Street, NW, License Number, ABRA 115711.

This is a retailer Class CT licence renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet, and residential parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

My name is Laverne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is anyone present on behalf of Buho's Restaurant? Is anyone present of Buho's?

MR. CYPRESS: I'm online. My name is Brandon.

MS. FLETCHER: Brandon, you're here representing Buho's Restaurant?

MR. CYPRESS: Oh, no. Sorry.
MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, I'm asking is anyone present on behalf of Buho's Restaurant?

MR. CYPRESS: Got you.
MS. FLETCHER: All right. We'll note for the record that the owners for Buho's
actually appeared in person. So they were here in person. So obviously they couldn't join us in this session.

So I am not dismissing them, because they came in person literally. But I just wanted to check to see if they had been able to call in. But I see they weren't able to call in. But they were here.

We have a group of five or more. Is anyone present on behalf of the group?

MS. MAI: Good morning, this is Jessica Mai again.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Mai.
MS. MAI: Last name is M-A-I.
MS. FLETCHER: And could you spell the first name, please?

MS. MAI: J-E-S-S-I-C-A.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone else?

MR. RUSSELL: Yeah, my name is Mark Russell, spelled M-A-R-K R-U-S-S-E-L-L.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Russell. Anyone else present from the group today?

MR. BROOKINS: Yes, this is Timothy Brookins, T-I-M-O-T-H-Y B-R-O-O-K-I-N-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Brookins, anybody else?

MS. EARLE: Yes, this is Kiara Earle, spelled K-I-A-R-A, last name, E-A-R-L-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. DEGAGNE: Dan Degagne, D-A-N, last name, $\mathrm{D}-\mathrm{E}-\mathrm{G}-\mathrm{A}-\mathrm{G}-\mathrm{N}-\mathrm{E}$.

MS. FLETCHER: Anyone else?
MR. WEI: Yeah, Larry Wei, W-E-I, L-A-R-R-Y, space, W-I-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone else?

MS. McCLURE: This is Jessica McClure, J-E-S-S-I-C-A, last name, M-C-C-L-U-R-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Thanks, anybody else?
MR. RAMESH: This is Kylash Ramesh, K-Y-L-A-S-H, last name, Ramesh, R-A-M-E-S-H.

MS. FLETCHER: Anyone else?
MR. CYPRESS: Brandon, B-R-A-N-D-O-N, last name, C-Y-P-R-E-S-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Cypress?
MR. CYPRUS: Cypress, like C as in cat, $Y$, as in --

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, thank you. Anyone else?
(No audible response.)
MS. FLETCHER: I count nine, which means that your group is granted full standing as a protestant.

We need to set a date for a mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing. I will give you the dates for the status and protest hearing first. The status hearing is scheduled for April the 5th, April the 5th, 2023, at 10:30 a.m. The protest hearing is set for May the 10th, 2023, at 1:30 p.m.

I will give you the next available day for mediation, and then I'll run whatever date you choose by the Applicant and get back to you to confirm. The next available day on the calendar is, excuse me one second here, the next available day is Thursday, March 23rd, anytime between 10:00 and 1:30.

And Ms. Mai, you and/or Mr. Russell will be appearing on behalf of the group for mediation. Will anyone else be attending?

MR. RUSSELL: Yes, one of us will be there. This is Mark Russell.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so we'll check --uh-huh?

MR. RUSSELL: We are able to forward it to the other people present today as well, correct?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MR. RUSSELL: Okay, great.
MS. FLETCHER: So does the 23rd, anytime between 10:00 and 1:30 work for you, Mr. Russell, or Ms. Mai?

MR. RUSSELL: You said April 23rd or March 23rd?

MS. FLETCHER: March 23rd, that's a Thursday. If not, we can keep moving through the calendar. That's just the next available day.

MR. RUSSELL: March 23rd at what time?

noon a possibility?
MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MR. RUSSELL: Okay, let's do noon.
MS. FLETCHER: And so let me ask you to do something. Because the Applicant is not here, give me a second date that you would also be available at noon. Would you be available also at noon on March the 29th? That's the next Wednesday, I mean, that's Wednesday.

MR. RUSSELL: I'm not, but Jessica, are you available that day?

MS. MAI: Yes, 28 or 29 March at 12:00 p.m. Eastern Time works.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So I'm going offer the Applicant the 28th at noon. And if for some reason he's not available, then I will offer him the 29th. And I'll get back to you to confirm.

MR. RUSSELL: Okay, great. Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Any questions at all? Okay. Well, in that case, no questions, the roll call hearing in this matter is concluded. Thank you for coming, and I'll see you in mediation.

MS. MAI: Great, thank you very much.
MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.
