This is a retailer Class CR new license application. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet, residential parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety, and real property values.

11	MR. ANDARGATCHEW: Hi, Ms. Fletcher,
12	Chris is not available today, but there is few of
13	us online from the condo.
14	MS. FLETCHER: So we can start with
15	you then.
16	MR. ANDARGATCHEW: My name is Dag

20	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
21	Anybody else from this group?
22	And so who's representing this group
23	today, or is there a designated representative
24	for this group today? So according to our record
25	and it doesn't matter, I'm just asking just

1 for clarity. 2 MS. DORSEY WILLIS: Yes, this is Robyn 3 here. I'm representing on behalf of Chris today. Okay. Is that Sarah? 4 MS. FLETCHER: 5 MS. DORSEY WILLIS: Robyn. 6 MS. FLETCHER: Robyn, okay, you're 7 here for Chris today. Okay. I have a question 8 for you. 9 MS. DORSEY WILLIS: Sure. 10 MS. FLETCHER: I read your protest 11 I just need to clarify your intent. letters. So 12 there are two things going on in your protest 13 letter. One thing is that you start out 14 mentioning that you're filing the protest as a condominium association. 15 16 But then as you go on, it gets to the 17 point where it appears that you are filing your 18 protest as a group of five or more. So do you 19 know what your intention was in filing the 20 protest? Are you trying to file it as both a 21 condo association and as a group of five? 2.2 MS. DORSEY WILLIS: That's a great 23 question. I guess whichever works --2.4 MS. VALERO: Robyn, sorry, maybe I can

chime in. Because I was in --

1 (Simultaneous Speaking.) 2 MS. FLETCHER: Excuse me. The other 3 thing, before you speak, let the court reporter know who's speaking. So, Robyn, you were just 4 5 speaking. Yes, this Sarah. 6 MS. VALERO: 7 MS. FLETCHER: Somebody else is going 8 to speak now? MS. VALERO: Yes, this is Sarah 9 Valero. 10 11 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. 12 MS. VALERO: I was trying to chime in, 13 because I was part of the conversation with Chris Coit and the Council member for the 6 ANC. 14 15 were trying to get some guidance as to what would 16 be the best format for us to file the protest. And the last piece of advice that we 17 18 received is that, because we are an abutting 19 property, so we're right next to the space where 20 the Applicant intends to open the business, that 21 it was better for us to submit the letter as a 2.2 condo association. 23 However, because we are comprised of individual owners, we did have some of our owners 2.4

that wanted to sign the protest letter also

individually. I hope that helps.

MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, it's helpful.

And so your -- so condominium associations do not have standing to file a protest. If you were filing as a condominium association, that protest is dismissed, because condominium associations do not have standing as protestants.

And so now we are left with, it appears that we're left with the group. Because I have the signatures of numerous people that signed the protest letter. Normally if it's a condominium association, one person signs. But in this case there is a list of signatures.

And so that's why I was trying to get some clarity if your intention was to file as a group or as a condominium association. The condominium association, that's dismissed, so we're left with the group. So is your intention to proceed as a group?

MS. VALERO: Yes.

MS. FLETCHER: So what I'm going to do is this. The condominium association is dismissed, because your protest letter did start out saying that you were filing the protest as a condominium association.

1 But because you went on to say 2 something more and appeared to have signed as a 3 group, I'm going to grant conditional standing to 4 a group of five or more. Let me give you a 5 present today, which means that two additional 6 people who were not present today will need to 7 appear at the upcoming status hearing. 8 MS. VALERO: Thank you. 9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. So, 10 Ms. Willis, you're representing, how do you 11 pronounce his last name, Christopher Coit? 12 MS. DORSEY WILLIS: Yes, Christopher 13 Coit. 14 MS. FLETCHER: I'm going to spell that 15 for the record. Christopher is spelled C-H-R-I-16 S-T-O-P-H-E-R, the last name is spelled C-O-I-T. 17 MS. DORSEY WILLIS: Correct. 18 MS. FLETCHER: And also for the court 19 reporter, Mr. Morris, I'm going to spell your 20 name, because I forgot to ask you to do it. 21 spelled S-E-A-N, Sean Morris, M-O-R-R-I-S. 2.2 Morris is the attorney for Vybrations Restaurant. 23 So, Ms. Willis, do you have any 2.4 questions about what just happened? 25 MS. DORSEY WILLIS: No ma'am, I'm all

3	still continue to list Christopher Coit as the
4	designated representative unless
5	MS. DORSEY WILLIS: Yes.
6	MS. FLETCHER: unless you tell us
7	that you

9	MS. DORSEY WILLIS: And Chris is
10	perfect, thank you.
11	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
12	Then we have the ANC. ANC 6A filed a
13	protest
14	MS. MAI: Hi, we're also here for the
15	Buho's Restaurant roll call meeting. Where on
16	the agenda is that?
17	MS. FLETCHER: We haven't called that
18	case yet. That case hasn't been called yet.
19	MS. MAI: But it is happening during
20	this meeting today?
21	MS. FLETCHER: That case is on the
22	calendar for today, but it hasn't been called
23	yet.
24	MS. MAI: So should we remain on the
25	call then?

1	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, because well
2	yes, because the case has to be called.
3	MS. MAI: Perfect, okay. We will go
4	ahead and stand by. Thank you.
5	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So I don't know
б	if the court reporter needs to know who you are
7	since the case hasn't been called. But would you
8	state your name?
9	MS. MAI: This is Jessica Mai, M-A-I.
10	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, Ms. Mai, and
11	you're here for Buho's, B-U-H-O'S, Restaurant?
12	MS. MAI: BUHO'S, yes, thank you.
13	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
14	ANC 6A is also a protestant. Is
15	anyone present on behalf of ANC 6A?
16	MS. SULLIVAN: Yes, this is Erin
17	Sulllivan. I'm a chair of the Alcoholic Beverage
18	Licensing Committee for ANC 6A appearing on
19	behalf of ANC 6A. And my name is spelled Erin,
20	E-R-I-N, last name Sullivan, S-U-L-L-I-V-A-N.
21	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone else
22	from ANC 6A today?
23	MS. SULLIVAN: I don't believe so.
24	MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Sullivan, ANC 6A
25	does have standing as a protestant. I have a

1	question for you though.
2	MS. SULLIVAN: Yes.
3	MS. FLETCHER: We have listed the
4	names of four people from ANC 6A as
5	representatives. Can you pick one for us,
6	please?
7	MS. SULLIVAN: Yes, I think
8	Commissioner Mike Velasquez is going to be the
9	designated representative going forward.
10	MS. FLETCHER: Do you know the
11	spelling of his name?
12	MS. SULLIVAN: Yes. Bear with me one
13	second to make sure I get it correct.
14	MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
15	MS. SULLIVAN: Okay, so his first name
16	is Mike, M-I-K-E.
17	MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
18	MS. SULLIVAN: And his last name is
19	Velasquez, V as in Victor, E, L as in Lima, A-S-
20	Q-U-E-Z.
21	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
22	We need to set a date for mediation, a status
23	hearing, and a protest hearing. I'm going to
24	give you the date for the status and protest
25	hearing first. The status hearing is scheduled

1 for April the 5th, April the 5th at 10:30 a.m. for 2 the status hearing. The protest hearing is set for May the 3rd, May the 3rd at 1:30 p.m. for the 3 4 protest hearing. 5 I will give you the next available 6 day for mediation. The next available day for 7 mediation is Wednesday, March 15. Wednesday is a Board hearing day, so if anyone believes they 8 9 will have a hearing before the Board on Wednesday the 15th, then that's not going to be a good day. 10 11 But it is available. And that would be any time between 10:00 and 1:30. 12 13 So I'll start with you, Mr. Morris. Is 14 that a good day for you? 15 MR. MORRIS: I was just checking. Ι 16 believe it is. If you give me just one more 17 minute. I apologize. 18 MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, because I know 19 you may have something else on the Board's 20 calendar. 21 MR. MORRIS: Yeah. Thank you for your 2.2 indulgence. I just need one more minute. 23 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. 2.4 MS. JAFFARI: Ms. Fletcher, while he's 25 looking, I came in a little late to the meeting.

1	MS. FLETCHER: That's okay. Who's		
2	speaking?		
3	MS. JAFFARI: My name is Sima, it's		
4	spelled S like Sam, I, M like Mary, A, last name		
5	is Jaffari. It's spelled J-A-F-F, like Frank, A-		
6	R-I. I'm with Megan Kolodgy's group. We're in		
7	protest of the club, the Vybrations club. I		
8	don't know if you already called our group, but I		
9	need to leave here in about five minutes. I just		
10	wanted to announce myself.		
11	MS. FLETCHER: Well, yeah, that's the		
12	one that we're still in right now.		
13	MS. JAFFARI: Okay.		
14	MS. FLETCHER: So which group are you		
15	a part of?		
16	MS. JAFFARI: Megan Kolodgy's group.		
17	MS. FLETCHER: Okay.		
18	MS. JAFFARI: Yeah.		
19	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, I'll record that		
20	you were here.		
21	MS. JAFFARI: Okay, thank you. I		
22	didn't want to interrupt later. Thank you.		
23	MS. FLETCHER: No, that's fine. You		
24	can go ahead. I won't hold you.		
25	Ms. Kolodgy?		

1	MS. KOLODGY: Yes.			
2	MS. FLETCHER: That means that there			
3	are five people present from your group today,			
4	not four.			
5	MS. KOLODGY: Perfect.			
6	MS. FLETCHER: So that means that,			
7	rather than your being granted conditional			
8	standing today, your group is granted full			
9	standing.			
10	MS. KOLODGY: Amazing. Thank you.			
11	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Jaffari.			
12	MS. JAFFARI: Thank you.			
13	MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.			
14	MR. MORRIS: And, Ms. Fletcher, this			
15	is Sean Morris again. March 15th is a fine day			
16	for me.			
17	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, then what			
18	about I'm going to start with Ms. Kolodgy. Is			
19	the 15th a good day for you, Wednesday, the 15th,			
20	anytime between 10:00 and 1:30?			
21	MS. KOLODGY: Yeah, it's fine for me			
22	personally. So just for my own edification,

7	between 10:00 and 1:00 p.m.		
8	MS. FLETCHER: And what about Ms.		
9	Uzzell?		
10	MS. UZZELL: I should be able to make		
11	that work as long as I can participate virtually		
12	that day.		
13	MS. FLETCHER: As long as you can do		
14	what?		
15	MS. UZZELL: Participate virtually, if		
16	that's possible.		
17	MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, all of our		
18	proceedings are virtual right now so		
19	MS. UZZELL: Awesome.		
20	MS. FLETCHER: you're good. Yes.		
21	MS. UZZELL: Okay, thank you.		
22	MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.		
23	Mr. Belcher, what about you?		
24	MR. BELCHER: Yes, ma'am, we can make		
25	that work.
