The second charge in this case is failure to keep the kitchen open two hours before closing. The statutory authority is D.C. Code Section 25113(b)(1) and the term for this charge is also a warning.

Charge 3: substantial change, expansion to the second floor, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25762(b)(3).

The fine is \$1,000 to be paid within 120 days or the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

Charge No. 4: provide live entertainment without endorsement, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25113(a)(b)(1). The term for this charge is a warning.

Charge 5, allowed dancing without endorsement. Statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25113(a)(b)(1). The fine is \$1,000 to be paid within 120 days or the license will be suspended.

Charge 6, trade name trade. Statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25762(b)15 and the term for this charge is a warning and amend

hours. The statutory authority is D.C. Code
Section 25723(b) and the term is a warning will

For Case No. 19-CIT-00648, the charge is failure to file required quarterly statements third quarter of 2019, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25113(b)(2)(a). There is a fine of \$750 to be paid within 120 days or the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid.
