3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, the  
4 next case on our calendar is Case Number 26-PRO-  
5 00011, Rosemarino D'Italia, License Number  
6 109613. Mr. Orellana, can you please elevate the  
7 rights of the licensee and the protestant in this  
8 case?

9 MR. ORELLANA: Sure thing. Cameron  
10 Mixon, access elevated. Zachary Adams, access  
11 elevated. And that appears to be all, Chairman.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.  
13 Good morning Mr. Mixon, can you please identify  
14 yourself for the record?

15 MR. MIXON: Good morning, Mr. Chair,  
16 Cameron Mixon for the applicant, Rosemarino  
17 D'Italia. First name Cameron, C-A-M-E-R-O-N,  
18 last name Mixon, M-I-X-O-N.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning  
20 sir. Mr. Adams, can you please identify yourself  
21 for the record?

22 MR. ADAMS: Yes. Zachary Adams here  
23 for ANC 2B. Z-A-C-H-A-R-Y A-D-A-M-S.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Mr.  
25 Mixon, are there any preliminary matters?

1 MR. MIXON: None for the applicant.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Adams, any  
3 preliminary matters, sir?

4 MR. ADAMS: None for the ANC.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,  
6 thank you. Then this matter is scheduled for a  
7 protest hearing on April 1 at 1:30 p.m. Are the  
8 parties aware of the protest process, or do I  
9 need to read the instructions?

10 MR. MIXON: We are aware.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay, that's  
12 fine. Just remind the parties that the PIP is  
13 required seven days before the hearing and  
14 failure by either side to provide a PIP that  
15 identifies documents and witnesses that they wish  
16 to rely upon, the Board is empowered to prevent  
17 that side from relying on documents that have not  
18 been disclosed.

19 And I'm going to state this just  
20 especially for the ANC, I've seen other cases  
21 where statements might come in or like someone  
22 might send a letter to the Board. I just want to  
23 remind the ANC that when we have the hearing, you  
24 have to move those documents in the record, so  
25 not because they're in your PIP, if we don't

1 testimony and someone moved those documents into  
2 evidence at the hearing, then those documents  
3 will not be part of the record. Okay?

4 MR. ADAMS: Understood. So we need  
5 to make a motion at the hearing to move them into  
6 the record and --

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Move them,  
8 right. To move the documents into the record for  
9 them to be a part of the record.

10 MR. ADAMS: All right, understood.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay? All  
12 right. If this matter's now settled I will see  
13 you at the protest hearing on April 1 at 1:30  
14 p.m. Have a great day. Thank you.

15 MR. MIXON: Thank you, Mr. Chair.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You're  
17 welcome.
