The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson presiding.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I will now do our legal agenda for the morning.

The first matter on our legal agenda is a review of an offer -- this is a legal agenda alcohol -- review of an offer-in-compromise in lieu of a hearing, dated February 28, 2024, for case number 23-CMP-00079, Mirror Lounge, license number 111950.

The offer-in-compromise is as follows: charge one, played music from the establishment that could be heard in a premises outside of the establishment. DC Official Code, Section 25725(a). And there's a \$2,000 fine, payable within 30 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge two -- I'm sorry, give me one minute, please. We're off the record, just briefly. Okay? We're off the record briefly. (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter went off the record at 11:20 a.m. and resumed at 11:22 a.m.)

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, I apologize for -- I just want to make sure that I
was reading the right case. So, it's, again, the offer-in-compromise for case number 23-CMP-00079, Mirror Lounge, license number 111950.

So, charge one, played music from the establishment that could be heard in a premises outside of the establishment. DC Official Code, Section 25725(a).

So, there's a fine of \$2,000, payable within 30 days, or the license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge two, failed to follow settlement agreement. DC Official Code, Section 23823(a)(6). This charge will be dismissed.

I, therefore, make a motion that the offer-in-compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

Number three, a request from James Murphy for one-day license, Class F, the Traditional Irish Lamb Stew. This is on March 16th. The license number is 127872, 300 attendees, eight security guards.

Number four, a request from Natasha Soussanin, S-O-U-S-S-A-N-I-N. This is for oneday license, Class $F$. This is a reception. This event is on May 11, 2024. The license number is 127884, 150 attendees, three security guards, for this to be approved.

Number five is a request from Patrick DeBatista, for one-day license, Class G. This is a western line dance class. This is on March 30th. The license number is 127870, 200 attendees, four security guards, for this to be approved.

Number six, it's a request from Robert Jordan for one-day license, Class G, private event. This is on March 15th. The license number is 127900, 60 attendees, two security guards.

Number seven, a request from Bar Crawl Nation LLC. This is for pub crawl. This is for tacos and Mardi Gras crawl. This is May 4th and May 5th. The license number is 114535. The substantial change license is $24-$ PCE-00005. The motion is for 1,000 participants each day.

MEMBER SHORT: Short, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant? MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson, I agree. The matter passes 3-0.

And our final license for the day is a license administrative docket for March 13, 2024. There are fifteen applicants on this docket. And without objection, I make a motion that the license administrative docket, as published for Wednesday, March 13, 2024, be approved. Is there a second?

MEMBER SHORT: Short, I second.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll call vote. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Short, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant? MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr. Anderson, I agree. The matter passes 3-0. And we're now at the end of our agenda item.
