MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is Rosemarino D'Italia. This is Case Number 22-PRO-00012, 1714 C, LLC, the address is 1714 Connecticut Avenue, Northwest, License Number ABRA 109613.

This is a Retailer Class CT. This is a substantial change application for live entertainment with a cover charge inside the premises.

Is anyone present on behalf of the establishment?

MR. CAMACHO: Yes, ma'am. My name is Edward Camacho.

MS. FLETCHER: Could you state that one more time and spell it for the record?

MR. CAMACHO: Oh, Edward Camacho. E-D-W-A-R-D, last name Camacho, C-A-M-A-C-H-O.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Camacho. Is anyone else with you today?

MR. CAMACHO: At this very moment, no. It's just me representing --

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MR. CAMACHO: Rosemarino D'Italia,

1714 C, LLC.
MS. FLETCHER: And you're the representative for the establishment?

MR. CAMACHO: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 2B?

MR. RUECKGAUER: I am. Jeffrey Rueckgauer, Commissioner from 2B02.

MS. FLETCHER: Commissioner, could you spell your name for the record, please?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Certainly. Jeffrey J-E-F-F-R-E-Y, Rueckgauer R-U-E-C-K-G-A-U-E-R. And I'm the Commissioner from 2B02.

MS. FLETCHER: One second. Is anyone else with you today Mr. Rueckgauer?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Commissioner Roggensack is trying to get on. I think she's having trouble finding her link.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. We can -- we can go with you.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: If she joins us, I'll -- if she joins us I'll add her.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And then we
have a group of 51 Protestants. Let's see, let's start with is there a designated representative on behalf of the group of 51 present?

MS. NAVARO: Good morning. Yes, Ms. Fletcher, I'm Ann Navaro, A-V-A-R-O. And I'm the designated representative.

And with me today are eight other signatories from our protest.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you. If those individuals would state their names and spell them for the record, please?

MS. NAVARO: Why don't we start with May.

MS. NG: Yes, this is May Ng, M-A-Y
N-G.
MS. NAVARO: Jeff?
MR. CARNEAL: Jeff Carneal, J-E-F-F-R-E-Y, Carneal is C-A-R- like Nancy, E-A-L.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. NAVARO: Kraig?
MR. CONRAD: Kraig Conrad, K-R-A-I-G, last name $\mathrm{C}-\mathrm{O}-\mathrm{N}-\mathrm{R}-\mathrm{A}-\mathrm{D}$.

MS. NAVARO: Kevin?
MR. PROHASKA: Kevin Prohaska, K-E-V-I-N, last name Prohaska, P-R-O-H-A-S-K-A.

MS. NAVARO: Barbara?
MS. WAHL: Barbara Wahl, B-A-R-B-A-R-A W-A-H-L.

MS. NAVARO: William?
(No response)
MS. NAVARO: Oh, William's on mute.
MR. JOHNSON: Oh, William Johnson, J-O-H-N-S-O-N.

MS. NAVARO: And Deborah?
MS. JOHNSON: Debora Johnson, D-E-B-O-R-A, Johnson J-O-H-N-S-O-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Johnson, there is no -- there is no H - on the end of your name?

MS. JOHNSON: No $\mathrm{H}-$ on the end of my name.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. JOHNSON: D-E-B- as in boy, O-R-A.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. NAVARO: And then we have two -two more. Bruno?

MR. ALEONARD: Bruno Aleonard. It's B-R-U-N-O A-L-E-O-N-A-R-D.

MS. NAVARO: And I believe we have Nolan?

N - -
MS. FLETCHER: Wait. Bruno, would you spell your last name one more time?

MR. ALEONARD: I'm sorry, A-L-E-O-N-A-R-D.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. NAVARO: I'm sorry. Then Nolan.
MS. FLETCHER: Who's the other person?
MR. GUAGENTI: Nolan N-O-L-A-N. My last name is Guagenti. It's spelled just how it sounds. Just kidding. G-U-A --

MS. FLETCHER: And how is that?
MR. GUAGENTI: G- as in George, U-A-Gas in George, E-N-T-I.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Is that everyone Ms. Navaro?

MS. NAVARO: To my knowledge, yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. So, I've counted ten.

MS. NAVARO: Ten including me. That sounds right. I'm sorry if I misstated earlier.

MS. FLETCHER: Oh, that's good. At least five members from the group are present today. Which means that the group is granted full standing as a Protestant.

What that means, Ms. Navaro, is that at the upcoming status hearing, only you will need to appear as the designated representative for the group.

We're going to schedule a mediation in a minute. And only you would need to appear for the mediation as well.

But, generally only the designated representative appears for mediation. But, if there are other members from the group that you would like to appear, then that's fine. You would just let me know.

MS. NAVARO: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: So, we've got Protestants in this matter of ANC 2B, and the group of 51 represented by you, Ms. Navaro.

We need to set a date for mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing.

MR. ENGELMANN: Excuse me, Ms.
Fletcher. This --
MS. FLETCHER: Who's speaking? Mr. Engelmann?

MR. ENGELMANN: Yes. Dupont Circle Citizens Association filed a notice of pro-- a protest letter. And I'm here as their
representative as well in this matter.
MS. FLETCHER: So, this is the Dupont Circle Citizens Association. And Mr. Engelmann, I know that you're the designated representative for that group.

Could you spell your name for the record, please?

MR. ENGELMANN: Certainly. First name is Glenn, G-L-E-N-N. Last name is spelled E-N-G-E-L-M-A-N-N.

MS. FLETCHER: And so Mr. Engelmann, just so that you know, I didn't call the Dupont Circle Citizens Association because we received a settlement agreement between the Dupont Circle Citizens Association and the establishment prior to the roll call hearing.

MR. ENGELMANN: No, Your Honor. And I think Susan Volman, who is the President, sent an email and correcting them of misrepresentation.

There had been settlement discussions prior to an ANC meeting, drafted and circulated. We had signed on, but it was a three-party agreement.

The ANC did not sign on. And at the

11th and a half hour, some new disturbing facts came to our attention.

So, we had indicated to the operator that we were no longer interested in a settlement agreement per those terms, and needed to reconsider what, if anything, might be appropriate.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And so just a -thank you for that. What I'm basing -- what I'm basing my understanding on was that there was a settlement agreement is that we did receive a settlement agreement signed by Ms. Volman, V-O-L-M-A-N.

And so I understand what you're saying, Mr. Engelmann that settlement agreement was retracted?

MR. ENGELMANN: That's correct. Well, it was never finalized because the ANC didn't sign it.

MS. FLETCHER: Well, the ANC --
MR. ENGELMANN: And there's like a well-known fact from other proceedings the Board wouldn't have accepted it anyway without the ANC's signature.

MS. FLETCHER: Well, but actually they
would have. But, that's okay.
MR. ENGELMANN: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: It would have been okay
if only the DCCA entered into a settlement agreement without the ANC, that would have been fine. We would have accepted that.

But, I've made notes in the record here that the DCCA withdrew that settlement agreement. And so we're -- you're back in as a Protestant.

MR. ENGELMANN: Yes. Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: And so in that case, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association does have standing as a Protestant.

And so, Mr. Engelmann, you brought this to the attention of the Applicant already?

MR. ENGELMANN: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Camacho, were you aware of that before today?

MR. CAMACHO: No, I was not actually. I'm - -

MS. FLETCHER: So, --
MR. CAMACHO: Just use of going back and forth with Ms. Roggensack. I haven't received a follow up just yet in regards to the
situation.
All I know is that we were supposed to submit more information in regards to security operations, because --

MS. FLETCHER: Um-hum.
MR. CAMACHO: On the information that was presented, there were more concerns outside the venue once our operation has finalized and closed.

And as I mentioned, and as I spoke with a few representatives with ABRA, in order to receive overtime or have MPD be stationed outside the facility and venue, the entertainment endorsement would need to be approved as scheduled and sent over to them, in order to be provided MPD in front of the venue.

So, for what I'm understanding, the only thing I'm looking to do, the additional, is the entertainment endorsement.

Which, for the past few weeks, I was able to create a concept with Spear (phonetic) that fixes it and that is under my tavern license, which gives me the ability to still pay for --

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Camacho, I'm going
to interrupt for just a moment. Only to let you know that those are issues that can be discussed during our upcoming mediation.

And also, I have not had any communication with you directly. I've been in communication with Ms. Rosemeri Espinoza.

I'm going to spell that for the record.

MR. CAMACHO: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: It's R-O-S-E-M-E-R-I, that's her first name. The last name is Espinoza, that's E-S-P-I-N-O-Z-A.

And so let me ask you something. MR. CAMACHO: Yes.

MS. FLETCHER: Should we include you as a contact person? Or should we continue to be in touch with her?

MR. CAMACHO: You could be in touch with Rosemeri. Her emails are attached to mine, because she is my mother.

So, at this very moment --
(Simultaneous speaking)
MS. FLETCHER: I think her --
MR. CAMACHO: Outside the country for a family emergency. So, she had to fly to

Bolivia to handle a few things.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Perfect.
MR. CAMACHO: All right.
MS. FLETCHER: Then -- then we have three Protestants in this case now. We have the Dupont Circle Citizens Association, ANC 2B, and a group of 51.

MR. CAMACHO: Okay. Very good.
MS. FLETCHER: We need to set a date for a mediation, status hearing, and a protest hearing. I'll give you the date for the status and protest hearings first.

The status hearing is schedule for April 20. That's April 20, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. for the protest hearing.

MS. NAVARO: Ms. Fletcher, could I ask, you know, in the event --

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Nav -- Ms. Navaro, is that you speaking?

MS. NAVARO: Yes, I'm sorry, it is.
MS. FLETCHER: And this is just for the record. Thank you.

MS. NAVARO: Okay. Yes, this is Ann Navaro. I just wanted to ask if we need to substitute representatives prior to the date
because of conflicts or anything?
Is that permissible under your rules?
MS. FLETCHER: Well, you actually have five designated representatives for your group already. So, if any one of them can be here as a designated representative.

MS. NAVARO: Okay. Great. Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.
MR. RUECKGAUER: Ms. Fletcher, may I interrupt a second? Commissioner Roggensack appears to be on the line.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes?
MS. ROGGENSACK: Yes, thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Were you going to say something?

MR. RUECKGAUER: No.
MS. FLETCHER: One second, let me get back to -- Ms. Roggensack is on the line?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Ms. Roggensack, you are present on behalf of ANC 2B as well. Could you please state your name and spell it for the record?

MS. ROGGENSACK: Yes. My proper name is Margaret Roggensack. I am a Commissioner in

ANC 2B01.
And together with my colleague, Jeff Rueckgauer, represent the single member districts that include Rosemarino. Commissioner Rueckgauer represents the south side of our street.

I represent the north side, including the block of Connecticut on which Rosemarino is located.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And could you spell your last name?

MS. ROGGENSACK: Yes. R-0-G-G-E-N-S-A-C-K.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. Okay, Ms. Roggensack, I just stated that there's going to be a status hearing on April 20, 2022 at 10:30.

And just so that you know, ANC 2B has been granted standing as a Protestant. The protest hearing is set for May 18. May 18, 2022 at 1:30. That's for the protest hearing.

We need to set a date for mediation. I'll give you the next available day. The next available date for mediation is Tuesday, March 22.

That's Tuesday, March 22, if that's a
good day for the designated representatives.
MS. NAVARO: At what time?
MS. FLETCHER: Any time between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

MS. NAVARO: That time works for me.
Can I -- do you mind if I just poll a couple of other people? May, does that work for you?

MS. FLETCHER: So, Ms. Navaro, let me just -- let me just say this. Whenever you speak, just state your last name so that the court reporter knows who's speaking.

MS. NAVARO: This is Ann Navaro. That date works for me. Can I ask our other designated representatives?

May, does that work for you?
MS. NG: No. It doesn't
unfortunately.
MS. NAVARO: Jeff?
MR. CARNEAL: Yes, it can work for me, Jeff Carneal.

MS. NAVARO: Kraig Conrad?
MR. CONRAD: Kraig Conrad, no, unfortunately it does not work for me.

MS. NAVARO: Kevin Prohaska?
MR. PROHASKA: Same thing,
unfortunately it doesn't work for me.
MS. FLETCHER: So, are we trying to get a date (inaudible) Ms. Navaro?

MS. NAVARO: I'm sorry Ms. Fletcher, you were freezing.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Navaro, you're on -- yeah. So, are we trying to get a date for you or everybody? All the designated representatives?

MS. NAVARO: It doesn't have to be everyone. I just wanted to make sure a couple of people could do.

We can do that date if that works for the other people who have to come.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So, what about you, Mr. Engelmann? March 22?

MR. ENGELMANN: That date works for me.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And what about ANC 2B?

MS. ROGGENSACK: I'm available 9:00 to 12:00. From 12:00 on I would be unavailable.

MS. FLETCHER: What about 10:00? 10:00 a.m. on March 22?

MR. RUECKGAUER: That's fine with me.

MS. FLETCHER: Is that fine with everybody?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Yes. That works for me.

MS. NAVARO: This is Ann Navaro. That works for me.

MS. ROGGENSACK: Yes.
MR. CARNEAL: Jeff Carneal. Are these virtual meetings? Or are these live?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, they are virtual.
MR. CARNEAL: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: They are virtual.
MR. CARNEAL: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. Mediation is set for Tuesday, March 22 at 10:00 a.m.

Any questions at all?
MR. CAMACHO: Well, I -- well, this is Edward Camacho. Excuse me, but will I be attending this mediation hearing as well?

MS. FLETCHER: Well, I'm going to be sending the invitation to Ms. Espinoza. And sure, it's fine if you attend at well.

MR. CAMACHO: Perfect. Thank you so much.

MS. FLETCHER: You said that the email to her connects you, includes you as well, yes?

MR. CAMACHO: Correct, yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So yeah, it's -yeah, that invitation is extended to you as well.

MR. CAMACHO: That is perfect. Thank you so much.

MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome. Anything else?

MR. CAMACHO: So, I did have a question. And if I -- if you don't mind me asking, I know --

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Camacho?
MR. САМАСНО: Yes, oh excuse me. This is --

MS. FLETCHER: That's okay.
