CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, so let's get into our show cause hearing status calendar.

The first case on our calendar is 22-CMP-00099, Tres Creole Catering, License No. 111150.

Mr. Orellana, can you please elevate the rights of the Government and the licensee in this case, please?

MR. ORELLANA: It has been elevated.
Ralph Tyson, your access has been
elevated.
That appears to be all, Chair.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
MR. TYSON: All right, can you all see me?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, who is speaking?

MR. TYSON: Ralph Tyson here.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Also, we can't see you. Yes, I can.

All right. Good morning, Mr. Lutes. Can you please spell and state your name for the
record.
MR. LUTES: Good morning, Mr.
Chairperson. This is Assistant Attorney General Kevin Lutes for the District.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
Mr. Tyson, can you please spell and state your name for the record, please?

MR. TYSON: Yes. Ralph Tyson, R-A-L-PH T-Y-S-O-N.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
MR. TYSON: Morning.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Lutes, are there any preliminary matters in this case?

MR. LUTES: ANC has been communicated to the licensee. Other than that, no other preliminary matters.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, thank you.

All right. This matter is scheduled for a show cause hearing on April 5, 2023, at 1:30 p.m.

I want to advise both parties that if this matter can be settled, it can be settled through an OIC and then we can address this on our agenda, but if this matter is not settled

April 5, 2023 at 1:30 p.m. Seven days before the hearing, the parties are required to disclose the documents and witnesses that they will rely on at the hearing.

Failure by either party to disclose documents and witnesses seven days before the hearing, the Board is empowered to prohibit the introduction of documents and witnesses that have not been disclosed unless good cause has been shown.

Any questions by anyone?
MR. TYSON: Yes. I, actually, have a question, sir.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Mr. Tyson.
MR. TYSON: One of the charges, I'm, actually, because $I$ was not there at the moment, I am fine with settling this, but one of the charges is completely false.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Tyson?
MR. TYSON: Yes, sir.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry. Mr. Lutes, is this your case, sir?

MR. LUTES: Yes, Your Honor -- I'm sorry, yes, Mr. Chairperson, this is my case.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, Mr. Tyson,
you and Mr. Lutes can discuss this case.
MR. TYSON: I tried to. I tried to call him and discuss it, and he didn't want to remove the item that's on here. So, I thought that $I$ would have to come to the hearing in order to have it removed.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: It's, when I said remove, if the parties cannot settle the case, then --

MR. TYSON: Okay.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: -- we'll have a hearing, and then you then would have to provide testimony --

MR. TYSON: Documentation.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: -- documentation why you believe that you are innocent of that charge, sir.

MR. TYSON: No problem.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: As I said before, you can -- that's something that the parties can negotiate, and if failure of the parties to negotiate a settlement, an OIC, then we will have, then the Board will then decide, based on the presentation of evidence, whether or not the establishment is innocent or guilty of
the charge.
MR. TYSON: Okay.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay?
MR. TYSON: Yes, sir.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Tyson, I
will see you on April 5, 2023, at 1:30 p.m.
MR. TYSON: Yes, sir, do you mind if I reach out to you again?

MR. LUTES: You're free, yes. My apologies, you can reach out to me again.

MR. TYSON: Thank you very much, sir.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I like the fact that the parties talk, if this matter can be settled, then we don't have to have a hearing.

MR. TYSON: Okay.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, good luck with your discussion and negotiation, and have a great day. Thank you.

MR. TYSON: Thank you, you, too.
MR. LUTES: Thank you, Mr. Chairperson.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You are welcome.
