15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're on the  
16 record. Good afternoon, everyone. And welcome  
17 to the afternoon session of the ABC Board. My  
18 name is Donovan Anderson. I'm Chairman of the  
19 Board. We're joined by five other members of the  
20 ABC Board today, Mr. James Short, Mr. Bobby Cato,  
21 Ms. Rafi Crockett, Ms. Jeni Hansen, Mr. Edward  
22 Grandis.

23 The Board has six members in  
24 attendance today, and that constitutes a quorum.  
25 Before we get underway with this afternoon

1 calendar, I need to make a few exceptions very  
2 clear so that the conduct of these hearings is  
3 understand by everyone. There are four cases on  
4 this afternoon's calendar.

5 Once we take this case, I will take a  
6 moment for our IT specialist to elevate the  
7 rights for each party to enable their camera and  
8 microphone. Then and only then will you have the  
9 ability to enable your equipment. If your case is  
10 not being heard, you will remain mute and your  
11 camera will be disabled.

12 At the conclusion of each case, the  
13 parties will have the option to leave. If a  
14 party chooses to stay, all cameras and  
15 microphones for the concluded case will be  
16 disabled. Should you have any questions or  
17 require technical assistance during the hearing,  
18 please submit them using the question-and-answer  
19 feature. Excuse me.

20 Before we turn to our afternoon  
21 calendar, I need to do our legal agenda. And the  
22 first case in our legal agenda is a review of an  
23 offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing date  
24 March 14th, 2022 for Case No. 19-CMP-00049,  
25 Sticky Rice/Sing Sing Karaoke, License No.

1 072783. The offer in compromise is as follows.

2 There is the three charges. The first  
3 charge, offered entertainment after approved  
4 hours, D.C. Code Section 25113A, there's a fine  
5 of 2,000 dollars to be paid within 120 days or  
6 the license shall be suspended until the fine has  
7 been paid. Charge No. 2, no ABC manager on duty,  
8 statute or authority, D.C. Code Section 25701,  
9 the fine is a 2,000-dollar fine to be paid within  
10 120 days or the license shall be suspended until  
11 the fine has been paid.

12 For Charge No. 3, failure to have  
13 posted window lettering, statute or authority,  
14 D.C. Code Section 25701, that charge has been  
15 dismissed. I therefore make a motion that ABC  
16 Board approve the officer in compromise for the  
17 two charges for a total fine of 4,000 dollars to  
18 be paid within 120 days or the license will be  
19 suspended. Is there a second?

20 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has  
22 second the motion. We'll now have a roll call  
23 vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

18 License No. 115719. We're having a hearing this

19 afternoon, and so the Board will address this

20 motion at the hearing.

21 Number 6, review of the Chief of

22 Police request for a fact finding hearing dated

23 March 5th, 2022. This is for Martha's Market,

24 License No. 116862. The Chief of Police had

25 requested a fact finding hear. However, the ABC

1 Board -- I make a motion that we reject the
