CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're on the record. Good afternoon, everyone. And welcome to the afternoon session of the ABC Board. My name is Donovan Anderson. I'm Chairman of the Board. We're joined by five other members of the ABC Board today, Mr. James Short, Mr. Bobby Cato, Ms. Rafi Crockett, Ms. Jeni Hansen, Mr. Edward Grandis.

> The Board has six members in
attendance today, and that constitutes a quorum. Before we get underway with this afternoon
calendar, I need to make a few exceptions very clear so that the conduct of these hearings is understand by everyone. The are four cases on this afternoon's calendar.

Once we take this case, I will take a moment for our IT specialist to elevate the rights for reach party to enable their camera and microphone. Then and only then will you have the ability to enable your equipment. If you case is not being heard, you will remain mute and your camera will be disabled.

At the conclusion of each case, the parties will have the option to leave. If a party chooses to stay, all cameras and microphones for the concluded case will be disabled. Should you have any questions or require technical assistance during the hearing, please submit them using the question-and-answer feature. Excuse me.

Before we turn to our afternoon calendar, I need to do our legal agenda. And the first case in our legal agenda is a review of an offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing date March 14th, 2022 for Case No. 19-CMP-00049, Sticky Rice/Sing Sing Karaoke, License No.
072783. The offer in compromise is as follows.

There is the three charges. The first charge, offered entertainment after approved hours, D.C. Code Section 25113A, there's a fine of 2,000 dollars to be paid within 120 days or the license shall be suspended until the fine has been paid. Charge No. 2, no ABC manager on duty, statute or authority, D.C. Code Section 25701, the fine is a 2,000-dollar fine to be paid within 120 days or the license shall be suspended until the fine has been paid.

For Charge No. 3, failure to have posted window lettering, statute or authority, D.C. Code Section 25701, that charge has been dismissed. I therefore make a motion that ABC Board approve the officer in compromise for the two charges for a total fine of 4,000 dollars to be paid within 120 days or the license will be suspended. Is there a second?
